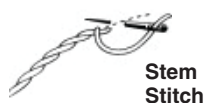

- Draw embroidery lines on the apples and leaves. Using 2 strands of embroidery floss for leaves and core and 3 strands for stems, embroider the leaves, core and stems. Use a stem stitch to embroider the details on the leaves, core and stems. Use a French knot to make the end of the stem.



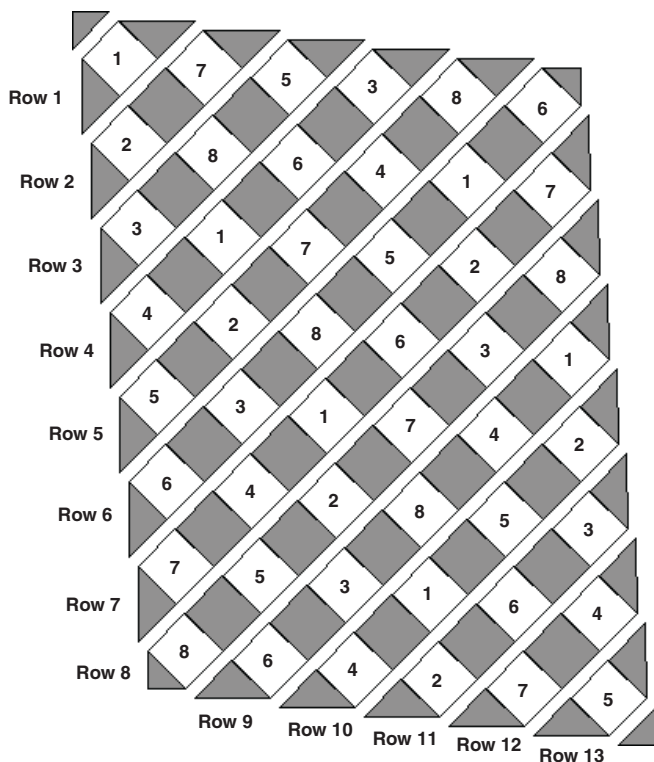
Stem

### Quilt Body Construction

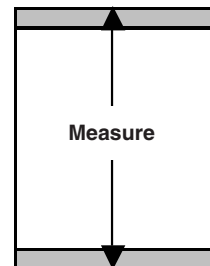
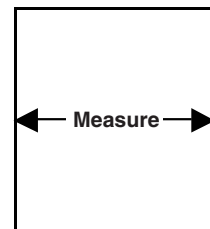
- Layout the quilt blocks (appliqué blocks and fabric 2 blocks), side triangles, and corner triangles in diagonal rows. Sew together as illustrated. The numbers in the blocks represent the colorizations shown in the appliqué directions.
- Sew rows together, then sew on the top left and bottom right corner triangles to make the body of the quilt. Press seams toward fabric 2.



**Border Directions** (If your measurements are different cut to your measurements) Press seams away from the body of the quilt.

### How to measure quilt for borders

- Measure the width of the quilt at the center of the quilt. Cut the top and bottom border to that measurement, and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- Measure the length of the quilt at the center to include the top and bottom borders. Cut the side borders to that measurement. Sew to the sides of the quilt.
- Repeat measurement process for each border.
