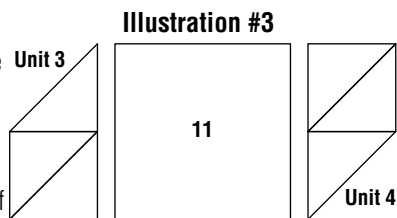


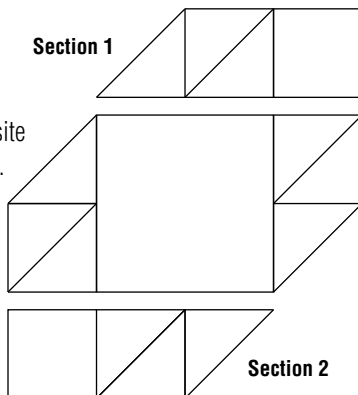
4. Sew Units 3 and 4 to opposite sides of the 4 1/2" Fabric 11 square as shown in Illustration #3. Press to large square.



****Important**** For the cowboy print to be upright in all of the blocks, you will make (12) blocks in each direction (facing up, down, right, and left) as demonstrated in Illustration #6.

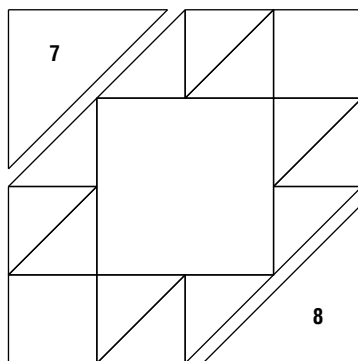
5. Sew Section 1 and Section 2 to opposite sides of the block as in Illustration #4. Press to large square.

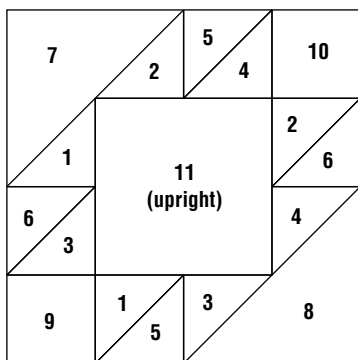
6. Sew the Fabrics 7 & 8 - 4 7/8" triangles to opposite ends of the blocks as in Illustration #5. Press to large triangle.

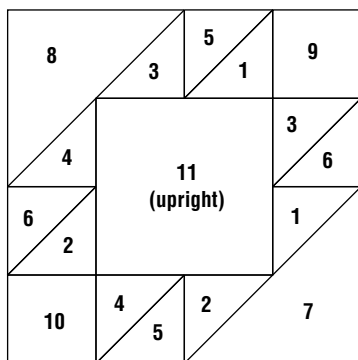


7. Repeat the block construction process to make a total of (12) each of Blocks A, B, C & D as shown in Illustration #6. **Be sure to have the cowboy motifs upright in each block.

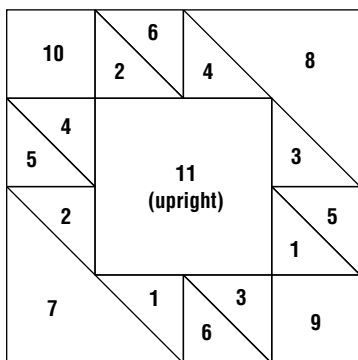
Illustration #6 (Make 12 of each Block)



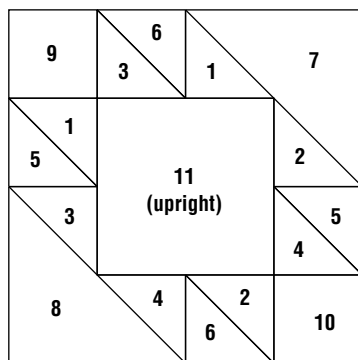

8. Following the block placement as shown in Illustration #7, sew the blocks together, setting them (6) blocks across by (8) blocks down.

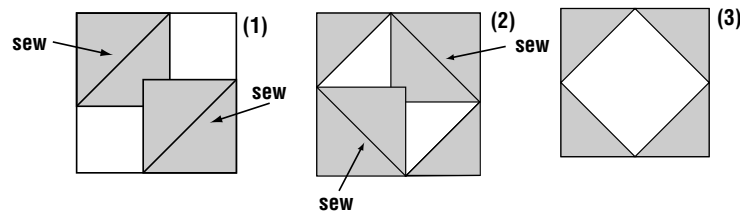

Corner units

9. Draw a line down the center, diagonally through the back of the Fabric 1 - 3 1/2" squares. As shown in Illustration #8, sew these to the Fabric 11 - 6 1/2" squares, sewing along the diagonal line, to opposite sides first (1), then the other two sides (2). Press to triangles and trim excess to 1/4" (3).

10. With border strips Fabric 1, sew two strips together for sides with bias seam. Trim to length of quilt. With the remainder of the strips, sew to the remaining two strips for top and bottom. Trim to width of quilt. Repeat with Fabric 10 border strip.

11. Sew Fabric 1 to Fabric 10 to create the border. Press to small strip.

12. Sew the corner units to each end of the top and bottom corner units, making sure the 1 1/2" strip is facing the quilt and the cowboy motifs are facing up.

13. Sew on side borders, then top and bottom borders. Making sure that the 1 1/2" strips are facing the quilt.

14. Layer, quilt, and bind using the 2 1/4" binding strips with a French binding technique.
