All seams are 1/4"-All strips are cut the width of fabric, except as instructed otherwise-carefully trim all selvages.

Skill Level: Intermediate - Advanced

An original design by Jinny Beyer, County Clare is a beautiful quilt design that gives an optical illusion of three-dimensional depth by fragmenting colors. The toile scenes are bordered and complemented by their surrounding fragmented diamonds and squares. Four identical x-shaped units make up this quilt. Each unit is a combination of eight fragmented parallelograms and four fragmented squares. The four x units are joined together with four bordered square toile scenes set on-point.

To finish the quilt, eight bordered half squares set on-point are set into the outer sections of the x's of the four original units. The quilt is classically finished in the traditional Jinny Beyer manner by the addition of a complimentary border.
