## Capturing the Three-Dimensional Design

To Capture the three-dimensional design it is important to follow the fabric placement. Refer to the quilt pictured and **Figure #6** for exact placement.

Units 1 & 1(r), 2 & 2(r), and 3 & 3(r) are identical in color. The difference between these individual units is the way the seams are pressed and the orientation of the strips in the fragmented block; i.e., left to right or right to left.

When piecing this quilt the bias of the quilt fabric will be sewn on, it is **important** to avoid stretching the fabric during the piecing process. To avoid stretching the fabric when machine piecing use a walking foot. If a walking foot is unavailable, block the fabric, or, have the bias fabric on the bottom of the two fabrics (**against the feed dogs**) to minimize stretching the fabric.

## Constructing the Strip Sets

- From the  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " strips cut from fabrics 1-15, construct three individual strip sets for each Unit. See **Figure #1**.

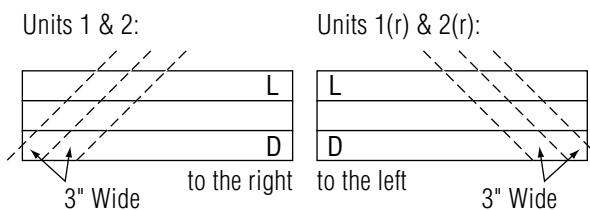
The arrows show the direction to press the seams when constructing the strip sets.

## Making the Fragmented 45° Diamonds

- To make Units 1, 1(r), 2 and 2(r), cut each strip set into 45° diagonals at 3" increments. Cut 8 diagonals from each strip set. For Units 1 & 2, cut the diagonal to the right. For Units 1(r) & 2(r), cut the diagonal to the left. See below before cutting, ensure the strip set is in the proper order – lighter fabric on top of set and darker fabric on the bottom.

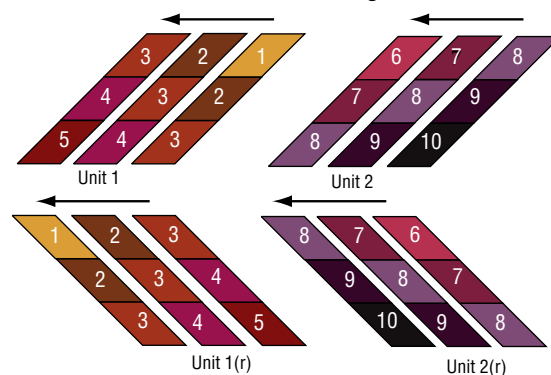


### NOTE:

Cut all three strip sets for each unit as shown.

- After cutting the strip sets into individual strips, use Template G for the point trimmer and trim the two 45° angles. This allows for easier alignment when piecing the strip set together.

Construct the 45° diamonds as shown in **Figure #2**.

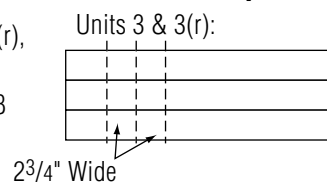

(For hand piecing, make eight units for each parallelogram shown in Figure #2. When pressing the seams follow the direction of the arrows in Figure #2 for both hand and machine piecing.)

## Making the Fragmented 9-Patch Squares

- To make Units 3 and 3(r), cut each strip set into  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " increments. Cut 8 from each strip set.



### NOTE:

Cut all three strip sets for each unit as shown.
