

Use of Paper Templates

1. Photocopy the templates and cut them out along cutting lines using rotary tools.
2. Place a loop of tape on the wrong side of the template.
3. Cut a strip of fabric the indicated size according to the cutting chart. The fabric should be folded in half with wrong sides together.
4. Lay the template on the fabric, matching grain lines, and press down so that the tape can hold it in place.
5. Place a rotary ruler over the paper template, matching sewing line with $\frac{1}{4}$ " marking on ruler.
6. With a rotary cutter, cut along edge of ruler. Repeat with all sides of shape.
7. Remove template and replace on fabric strip to cut second set of shapes.
8. There will be [2] shapes cut at one time. When using A and AR template, one of each will automatically be cut.
