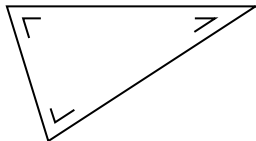


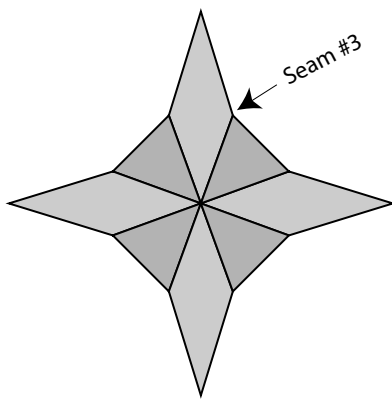
## Piecing Instructions

1. Mark all seam intersections on WRONG side of all pieces using marker of choice and ruler with 1/4" markings. On light fabrics use a mechanical pencil with a small lead or permanent markers with a small point. On dark fabrics use pencil, chalk or a white pencil. Also mark the center of C with a small X in the wrong side seam allowance

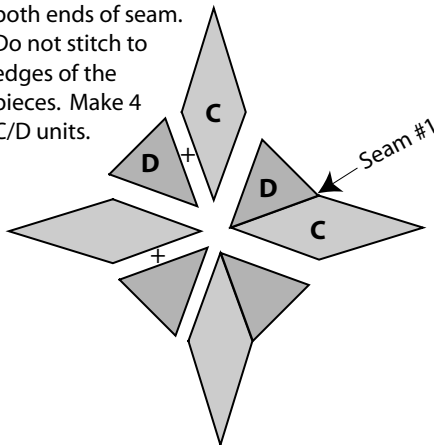


Set-in seams often take extra fabric in the sewing process. To prevent the blocks from being less than 8 1/2" [8" finished], sew about 1 thread less than a regular 1/4" seam.

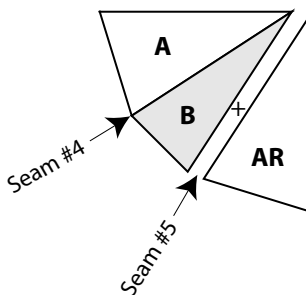
4. Sew Seam #3 using set-in technique



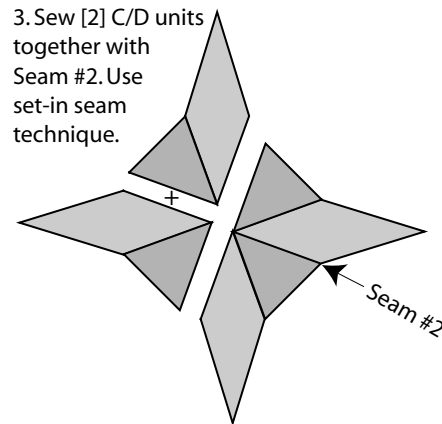
2. Lay out pieces according to diagram. Make sure that C has marked X's to the center. All seams in this block are set-in. Place right sides of C and D together and match seam intersections as previously marked. Pin through seam intersections. Begin and end stitching at these intersections. Back stitch to secure both ends of seam. Do not stitch to edges of the pieces. Make 4 C/D units.



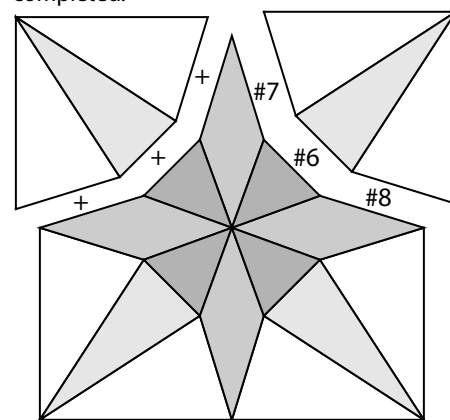
5. Lay out pieces A, AR and B. Sew seams #4 and #5 using set-in technique. Make [4] of these A/B/AR units.



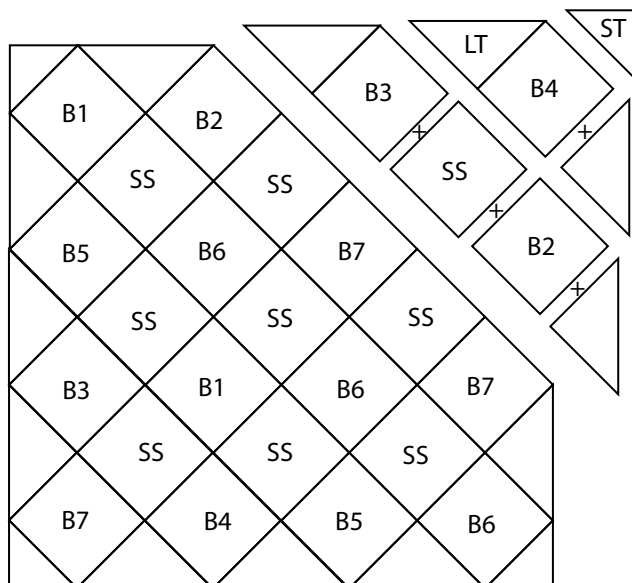
3. Sew [2] C/D units together with Seam #2. Use set-in seam technique.



6. Using set-in seam technique, sew Seams #6, #7, and #8. Repeat with all [4] A/B/AR units. Press all seams when block is completed.



**NOTE: You will need to make two each of all blocks except for Blocks 6 & 7, of which you will make three.**



**B = Block # SS = Setting Square LT = Large Triangle  
ST = Small Triangle**

7. Check the size of all pieced blocks. They should measure 8 1/2". If they are smaller, adjust SS to the same size. Lay out blocks and setting triangles. Sew together in rows. Sew rows together as indicated. Trim so that there is a 1/4" seam allowance on all sides.

## Binding

Sandwich quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired by machine or hand. Cut [7] binding strips 2 1/2" x width of fabric. Scraps can also be used. Sew strips together, press in half and stitch to right side of quilt. Fold to back of quilt and sew by machine or hand.

## Inner Pieced Border

8. Arrange 3" squares in pleasing color scheme. Sew [2] strips of [18] squares. Attach these to sides of quilt, trimming as necessary. Sew [2] strips of [20] squares together and attach to top and bottom. Attach outer side borders, followed by outer top and bottom borders.
