

4. Because this quilt is rectangular, to ensure that the motifs will match at the corners, it is necessary to sew a seam in the center of each side border strip as follows. Place one of the cut top/bottom inner border strips on one of the border print $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 32" strips, matching the fabric

design. Cut one miter to match the miter on the cut strip. Place the newly cut strip along the length of the quilt with the miter at the edge of the quilt (**Figure 2**). Bring the strip to the exact center of the quilt and cut it off $\frac{1}{4}$ " beyond the center.
