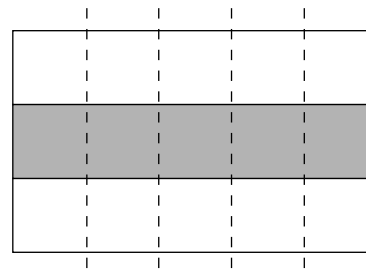

Block #1 - 150 Nine Patches

Sew a strip of the same 1930s print, 1 1/2" x 10" to each side of a background 1 1/2" x 10" strip. Press seams to outside.

Sew a background strip 1 1/2" x 6" to each side of the same 1930s print, as above, 1 1/2" x 6" strip. Press seams toward center. Cut both strips into 1 1/2" segments.



Fabric Requirements and Cutting Directions

Fabric	Area	Cut	Yardage
(50) Assorted 1930s fat quarters	150 Nine-Patch Blocks + 20 Star Blocks Border #3	(1) - 1 1/2" Strip – Cut into 1 1/2" x 10" and 1 1/2" X 6" pieces. (1) - 1 1/2" Strip – Cut into 1 1/2" x 10" piece. (1) - 2 3/8" Strip – (4) 2 3/8" squares <input type="checkbox"/> for stars (you need only 20 different colors). (1) - 1 1/2" Strip of all colors.	50 assorted fat quarters
Black Print	Border #1	(8) - 1 5/8" Strips WOF.	1/2 Yard
Yellow Print	Binding	(10) - 2 1/4" Strips WOF.	7/8 Yard
White Print	Background Border #2 Border #4	(13) - 1 1/2" Strips WOF - Cut into 1 1/2" x 10" pieces. Cut 50 pieces. (15) - 1 1/2" Strips WOF - Cut into 1 1/2" x 6" pieces. Cut 100 pieces. (10) - 3 1/2" Strips WOF - Cut into 3 1/2" squares. You need 120 squares for the large nine patches. (3) - 4 1/4" Strips WOF - Cut into 4 1/4" squares. <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> You need 20 squares and 80 pieces. (4) - 2" Strips WOF - Cut into 2" squares. You need 80 squares. (10) - 2" Strips WOF - Cut into 2" x 9 1/2" pieces. You need 40 pieces. (7) - 2" Strips WOF - Cut into 2" x 6 1/2" pieces. You need 40 pieces. (2) - 3 1/2" Strips WOF - Cut into 3 1/2" squares. You need 20 squares for stars. (2) - 14" Strips WOF - Cut into (5) 14" squares. <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> You need 18 pieces. (1) - 7 1/4" Strip WOF - Cut into (2) 7 1/4" squares for corners. <input type="checkbox"/> (8) - 3 3/4" Strips WOF. (9) - 5" Strips WOF. Take one of these strips, and cut into (2) 5" x 21" pieces.	7 1/4 Yards
Any coordinating fabric (44" wide)	Backing		8 Yards

All fabric cut WOF width of fabric 42" wide. Cut square in half diagonally once. Cut square in half diagonally twice.
