

# Floral Garden Charm

## Fabric Requirements

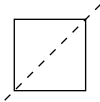
20 assorted fat quarters  
 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yards of beige vine (4803-2) for background  
 2 yards of red tonal leaves (4811-1) for border #1 and quilt  
 3 yards of large blue floral (4812-1) for border #2 and quilt  
 3/4 yard blue vine (4803-3) for binding

## Instructions

**Please read all instructions before you begin.** This quilt is a scrap quilt. Cut material as needed for a balanced scrap quilt. Directions are for speed cut units. The 3 yards of the large blue floral (4812-1) include enough for 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yards to be allotted to the outer border, and 1/2 yard left over to be used as Unit Bs and Unit Cs.

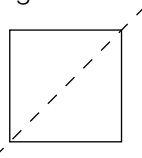
### UNIT A

From background, beige vine (4803-2), cut (14) strips 3<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" by width of fabric. From these strips, cut (144) squares 3<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>". Cut each square once diagonally. This should yield 288 half square triangles.



### UNIT B

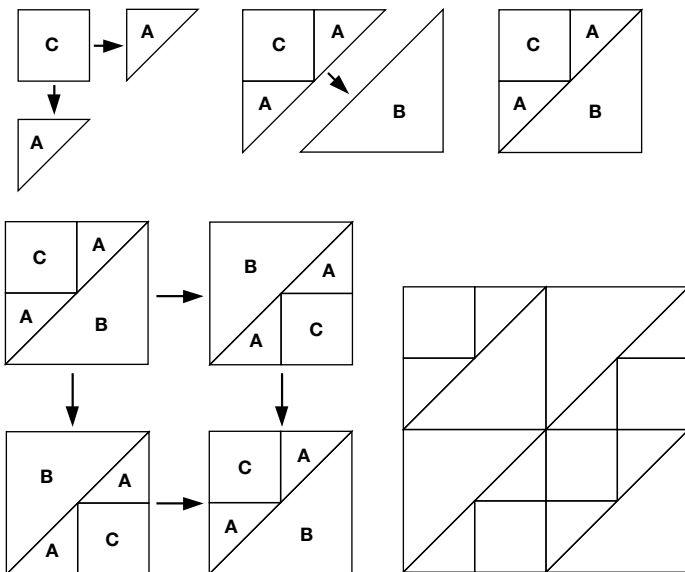
From assorted fat quarter fabrics and 1/4 yard of large blue floral (4812-1), cut as needed (72) 6<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" squares. Cut each square once diagonally. This should yield (144) half square triangles.



### UNIT C

From assorted fat quarter fabrics and 1/4 yard of large blue floral (4812-1), cut (144) 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" squares.

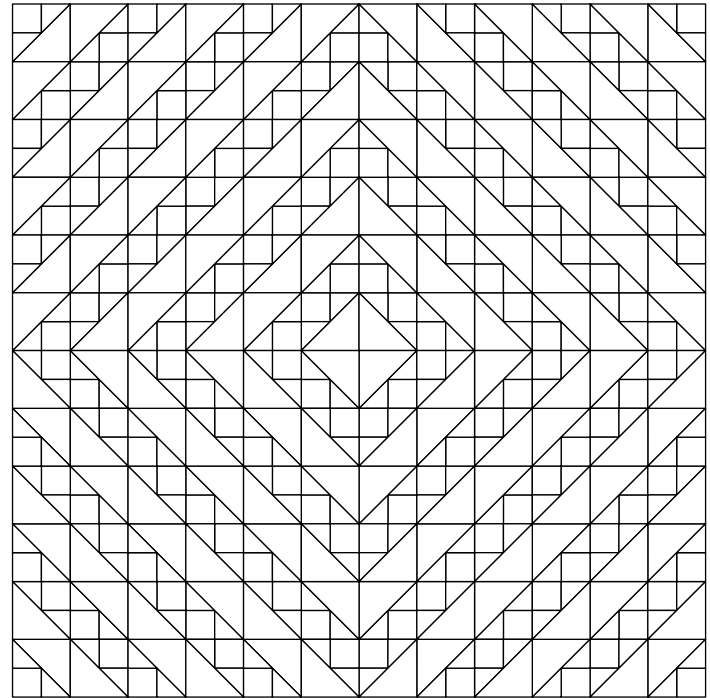
## Piecing the Block (as illustrated below)



Each block consists of (4) pieced units.

Make (36) 11<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" blocks (11" finished size).

## Setting it Together

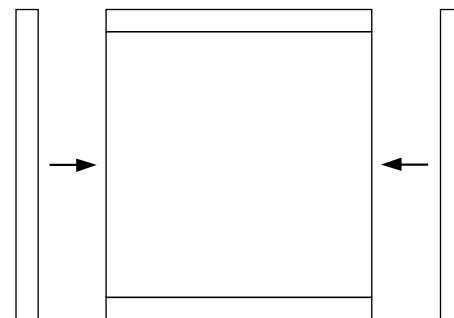


Set blocks in six rows of six in barn-raising style (see cover).

### Border 1, from red tonal leaves (4811-1)\*:

Cut (2) strips 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 66<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>". Sew to top and bottom of quilt. Cut (2) strips 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 70<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>". Add to sides.

\*Measure quilt top through middle. Make changes as necessary. If measurements are different, cut according to your measurements.



### Border 2, from large blue floral (4812-1):

Cut (2) strips 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 70<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>". Sew to top and bottom of quilt. Cut (2) strips 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 82<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>". Add to sides.

## Finishing

Quilt as desired.

For binding, use blue vine (4803-3).
