

# FLORAL PARADISE

## COLORWAY 2

Finished quilt size 82" x 82"

All strips are to be cut crosswise on the grain of the fabric (width of the fabric).

Yardage is calculated for 42" wide fabric.

Carefully trim off all selvages. **Please read the pattern carefully before you begin.**

Fabric #	Style #	Cutting Directions
1	4888-1	Cut a 29" square for the background of the <i>broderie perse</i> appliqué center medallion.
2	4885-3	Using the pictured quilt as a guide, cut one tree of life motif, four bird motifs, and floral motifs for the <i>broderie perse</i> appliqué. Leave scant 1/4" seam allowance around the motif for hand or invisible machine appliqué. If using a fusible, raw edge appliqué method trim motif exactly.
3	4885-1	Cut (2) 4 7/8" strips. Cut (12) 4 7/8" squares. Cut each square once on the diagonal for a total of 24 triangles.
4	4891-1	Cut (9) 2 1/4" strips for binding. Set aside. Cut (4) 2 1/2" strips. Trim two of these strips to 2 1/2" X 34 1/2". Trim the other two strips to 2 1/2" X 38 1/2". <b>Refold remaining fabric and cut all other Fabric 4 strips lengthwise.</b> Cut (7) 2 1/2" strips. Trim two of these strips to 2 1/2" X 54 1/4". Trim two strips to 2 1/2" X 50 1/4". Trim two strips to 2 1/2" X 30 7/8". Trim the last strip into (2) 2 1/2" X 26 7/8" strips. Cut (2) 6 7/8" strips. Cut (14) 6 7/8" squares. Cut each square once on the diagonal for a total of 28 triangles. To save fabric, trim the unused portions of the 2 1/2" strips down to 2 1/8". Cut (32) 2 1/8" squares. Cut (1) 2 7/8" strip. Cut (17) 2 7/8" squares. Cut (1) 2 7/8" square once on the diagonal for a total of two triangles. Cut (1) 1 3/4" strip. Cut (33) 1 3/4" squares.
5	4887-1	Cut (3) 2 1/8" strips. From one strip cut (16) 2 1/8" Squares. From the other two strips cut (16) 2 1/8" X 3 3/4" rectangles. To save fabric, trim the unused portion of the 2 1/8" strip to 1 3/4". Cut (4) 1 3/4" Squares. <b>Refold the fabric and cut all other Fabric 5 strips lengthwise.</b> Cut (4) 5 3/8" strips. Trim two strips to 5 3/8" X 50 1/4". Trim the other two strips to 5 3/8" X 40 1/2". Cut (5) 2 7/8" strips. Cut (86) 2 7/8" squares. Cut 14 squares once on the diagonal for a total of 28 triangles. Cut (1) 1 3/4" strip. Cut (28) 1 3/4" squares.
6	4893-1	Cut (8) 2 1/2" strips. Set aside for last inner border. Cut (4) 1 1/2" strips. Trim two of these strips to 1 1/2" X 40 1/2". Trim the other two strips to 1 1/2" X 38 1/2". Cut (2) 2 7/8" strips. Cut (18) 2 7/8" squares. Cut two of these squares once on the diagonal for a total of 4 triangles. To save fabric, trim the unused portion of the second 2 7/8" strip down to 2 1/2". Cut (8) 2 1/2" squares. Cut each square once on the diagonal for a total of 16 triangles. Cut (2) 2 1/8" strips. Cut (20) 2 1/8" squares. Cut each square once on the diagonal for a total of 40 triangles. To save fabric, trim the unused portion of the 2 1/8" strips to 1 3/4". Cut (5) 1 3/4" squares. Cut (1) 1 3/4" strip. Cut (22) 1 3/4" squares for a total of (27) 1 3/4" squares.
7	4892-1	Cut (2) 2 7/8" strips. Cut (15) 2 7/8" squares. Cut one square once on the diagonal for a total of 2 triangles. To save fabric, trim the unused portion of the second 2 7/8" strip to 1 3/4". Cut (7) 1 3/4" squares. Cut (1) 1 3/4" strip. Cut (22) 1 3/4" squares. For a total of (29) 1 3/4" squares.
8	4889-1	Cut (2) 2 7/8" strips. Cut (20) 2 7/8" squares. Cut one square once on the diagonal for a total of 2 triangles. Cut (1) 1 3/4" strip. Cut (22) 1 3/4" squares. To save fabric, trim the unused portion of the second 2 7/8" strip to 2 3/4". Cut (4) 2 3/4" squares. Trim the remaining portion of the strip down to 1 3/4". Cut (7) 1 3/4" squares.
9	4890-1	Cut (1) 2 7/8" strip. Cut (14) 2 7/8" squares. Cut one square once on the diagonal for a total of 2 triangles. Cut (2) 1 3/4" strips. Cut (30) 1 3/4" squares.
10	4886-1	<b>Cut all strips lengthwise being very careful to center the column motifs in each strip.</b> Cut (4) 7" strips X the length of the fabric. Trim each strip to 7" X 69 1/2".
11	4894-3	Quilt Backing

### To Make the Center Medallion

Take the 29" square of Fabric 1 and gently fold it in half in both directions. Use these creases as placement guides for the *broderie perse* appliqués.

NOTE: The appliqué is done with the background square oriented on point as shown.



Using the pictured quilt as a guide, appliqué the tree, floral, and bird motifs to the background square, using the appliqué technique of your choice. With the design carefully centered, trim the finished appliqué block to 26 7/8" x 26 7/8".

Sew a 2 1/2" x 26 7/8" Fabric 4 rectangle to two opposite sides of the appliqué square.

Sew a 2 1/2" x 30 7/8" Fabric 4 rectangle to the other two sides of the appliqué square.

Using the template pattern provided, make a template from template plastic or cardboard. Carefully line up the corner of the template with an outer corner of the center medallion and mark the cutting line along the long side of the triangle. Repeat for each of the other three corners. Carefully cut each corner on the drawn line.
