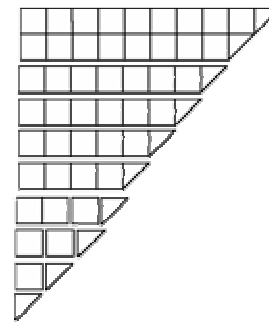


To Make the Postage Stamp Square Sections

Use the pictured quilt as a guide for fabric placement or place the fabrics randomly. Take the $1\frac{3}{4}$ " squares cut from Fabrics 4, 6, 7, 8 and 9. Set the squares into rows as shown in the diagram. On the right hand end of each row of squares, sew a $2\frac{1}{8}$ " Fabric 6 triangle. Now, sew the rows together as shown. The bottom row consists of a single $2\frac{1}{8}$ " Fabric 6 triangle. Repeat this procedure three times to make a total of four postage stamp sections. Sew one postage stamp section to each side of the center medallion as shown in the pictured quilt.

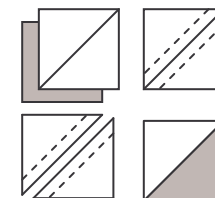


Borders 1, 2, 3 and 4:

Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $34\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 4 rectangle to the right and left sides of the center medallion.
Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $38\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 4 rectangle to the top and bottom of the center medallion.
Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $38\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 6 rectangle to the right and left sides of the center medallion.
Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 6 rectangle to the top and bottom of the center medallion.
Sew a $5\frac{3}{8}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric 5 rectangle to the right and left sides of the center medallion.
Sew a $5\frac{3}{8}$ " x $50\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric 5 rectangle to the top and bottom of the center medallion.
Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $50\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric 4 rectangle to the right and left sides of the center medallion.
Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $54\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric 4 rectangle to the top and bottom of the center medallion.

To Make the Pieced Squares:

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the (72) $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric 5 squares. Pair each Fabric 5 square with a $2\frac{7}{8}$ " square from Fabrics 4, 6, 7, 8 and 9. Right sides together, layer a Fabric 5 square on top of a colored square and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on either side of the marked line. Cut on the marked line to make two identical units. Press seams toward the darker triangles and trim the triangle tails. Repeat 71 times for a total of 144 pieced squares.



To Make the Pieced Border:

This border is assembled in sections. Use the pictured quilt as a guide for fabric placement or place fabrics randomly.

Sew three pieced squares together as shown to form one Unit A:
Repeat 23 times for a total of 24 units.



Sew a $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric 5 triangle to the left side of one completed Unit A to make Unit B:
Repeat 23 times for a total of 24 units.



Sew two pieced squares together as shown to form one Unit C.
Repeat 19 times for a total of 20 units.



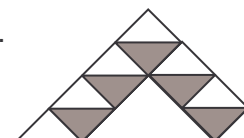
Sew a $2\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric 5 triangle to the right hand side of one Unit C to make Unit D.
Repeat three times for a total of 4 units.



Sew a $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric 3 triangle to each Unit C as shown.



Next, sew a Unit B onto the other side of the Fabric 3 triangles as shown to make Unit E.



Sew a $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric 3 triangle to each Unit D as shown.



Sew a Unit B onto the other side of the $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric 3 triangles as shown to make Unit F.
