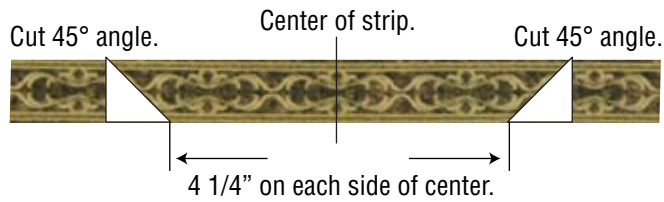
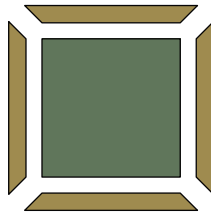


Constructing the Alternate Block

1. Fold the $8\frac{1}{2}$ " squares cut from Fabric 8, in half twice to get the centers of each side. Mark the center of the scroll strips and measure $4\frac{1}{4}$ " out from each side of center. Miter corners using a 45° right angle triangle.

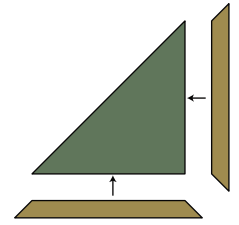


2. Sew strips to each side of the $8\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, starting and stopping the stitches $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each edge. Sew mitered corners. Make 12 blocks.

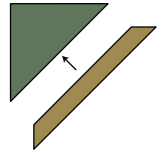


Constructing the Side and Corner Triangles

1. Fold the short sides of the triangles cut from the $12\frac{1}{2}$ " squares of Fabric 8 in half to find the center of each side. Following step 3 for alternate block, miter the strips and sew to each straight side of the triangle. Make 14 triangles.



2. For the corner triangles, fold the triangles cut from the $8" \times 8"$ squares of Fabric 8, in half to find the center. Stitch one mitered scroll strip to the long side of the triangle. Make 4 triangles.



Assembling the Quilt Top

1. The tree blocks and alternate blocks are turned on point and stitched together in a diagonal set. The side triangles are treated as blocks for piecing this quilt.
2. Stitch blocks together into diagonal rows, then stitch the rows together.
3. Stitch the corner triangles on after all the rows have been stitched together.
4. For the inner border cut the four $2"$ wide narrow stripe from Fabric 9, into two $62"$ long strips and two $78"$ long strips.
