

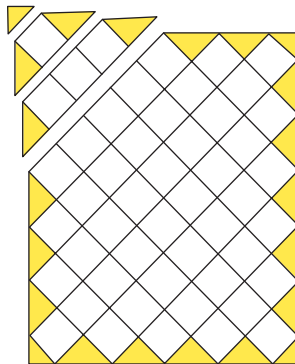


All Seams are 1/4" – All strips are cut the width of the fabric (WOF)

Swatch	Fabric	Cutting Instructions	Yardage
	Fabric: 8 7112-02 Set-in triangles, borders and binding	Cut three WOF strips 9 inches wide. From these strips cut nine 9 inch squares. From the fabric left over in these strips, cut two 7 inch squares. Cut the 9 in squares across diagonally to get 18 triangles. These are your "set in" triangles. Cut the two 7 inch squares diagonally to get 4 smaller triangles. These are your corner triangles. Cutting instructions for borders and binding to follow below.	5 yards
	Fabric 26 7100-01 Backing	Cut fabric into two 3-yard pieces. Leave selvages on. Matching right sides together, sew the two pieces of fabric together using a 1/2 inch seam. (Note: the fabric pattern will not match up at the seam). Trim seam to 1/4 inch wide. Leave on selvages on either end to give you more fabric to work with for your backing. Your backing should measure 87 inches by 108 inches.	6 yards

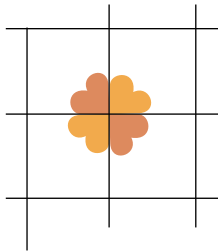
### Construction of quilt

Lay out white squares, mixing patterns, and adding set-in triangles according to illustration. Wait to square up sides until after applying appliques.



### Appliques

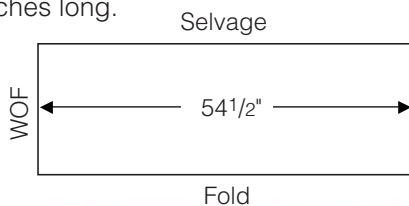
Lay out heart appliqué clusters where four white squares meet. Appliqué according to your favorite method. For the quilt in the photo, the heart appliques were ironed on with fusible webbing, and then stitched by machine using an appliqué stitch.



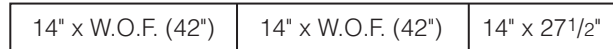
Quilt top will now measure approximately 54 1/2 by 66 1/2 inches. Square up and trim edges evenly before adding borders.

### Borders

From fabric 8, cut one WOF piece to fit the width of the top and bottom of your quilt top. Approximately 54 1/2 inches long.



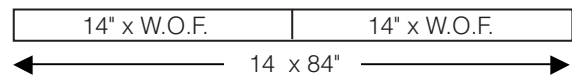
Carefully trim selvages making sure that the WOF measures 42 inches wide. Cut three 14-inch wide by 54 1/2 inch strips.



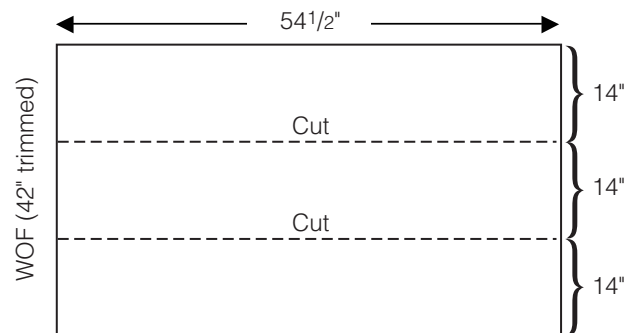
Sew two of these strips on the top and bottom of your quilt top.

From fabric 8, cut four WOF pieces 14 inches wide.

Sew each of two strips together at the ends to make two sets of 14 by 84 -inch strips. See diagram below.



Next take the remaining 14 by 54 1/2 inch piece, and cut it in half. Sew one half to the end of each of the 14



by 84-inch pieces. Measure and cut both pieces to fit the sides of your quilt. Sew side borders to your quilt top.

Your quilt top will now measure approximately 82 by 93 inches.
