















Hearts & Flowers

All strips are cut crosswise on grain of fabric (width of fabric) unless stated otherwise. All strips are based on 42" length. Carefully trim off all selvages. All seams are 1/4".

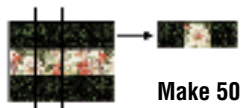

Fabric requirements and cutting directions

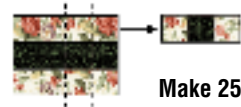
Fabric Swatch	Style #	Fabric Amounts	Cutting Directions
	4803-2	2 yards	Cut 4 strips length of grain (length of fabric) 7 1/2" x 64 1/2". Cut 5 strips length of grain 2 1/4" x 72" for the binding.
	4811-12	2 1/4 yards	Cut (4) 14" strips. Cut each 14" strip into (12) 3 1/2" x 14" as shown to the right. Remaining fabric used for border vines. 
	4812-2	6 yards	Cut length of grain (length of fabric) 14" from the trimmed selvage, the entire 6 yards of fabric, yielding (3) 14" x 216" strips, as shown below. Proceed cutting in order given below. Refer to cover photo for cutting placement.  For 24 alternate blocks, trim 9 1/2" x 14" strip to a 9 1/2" square. Cut (4) 5 1/2" squares for corner blocks. "Excess fabric" is cut every 3 1/2" to yield (68) 3 1/2" x 14" strips. 
	4828-2	1/2 yard	Cut (8) 1 1/2" strips. Remaining fabric used in appliquéd border.
	4829-2	1/4 yard	Cut (1) 4 3/8" strip. Cut strip into (8) 4 3/8" squares. Cut squares in half as shown to the right. 
	4803-1	1/8 yard each	See appliqué portion of pattern.

Nine patches:

Sew two green 14" x 3 1/2" strips to either side of 14" x 3 1/2" excess floral fabric. Repeat 16 more times to yield 17 sets. Cut sets into 3 1/2" strips as shown to the right. Due to cutting variances, three strips are allotted per set, even though four can be met.



Sew two 14" x 3 1/2" excess floral fabric to either side of a green strip. Repeat eight more times to yield nine sets. Cut these sets into 3 1/2" strips as shown to the right. Due to cutting variances, three strips are allotted per set, even though four can be met.



Sew 25 nine patch blocks together as shown to the right.



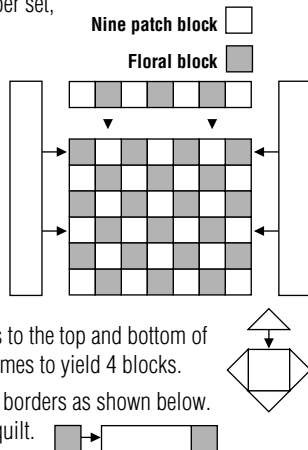
Quilt construction:

Sew nine patch blocks to alternate floral blocks. Refer to cover photo for placement. Sew borders to the sides as shown.

Square-in-a-square block:

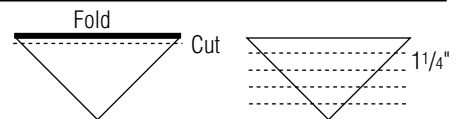
Sew 4 3/8" half square triangles to either side of 5 1/2" floral squares. Then sew remaining triangles to the top and bottom of the square as shown to the right. Repeat 3 more times to yield 4 blocks.

Attach these blocks to either end of the remaining borders as shown below. Then attach borders to the top and bottom of the quilt.

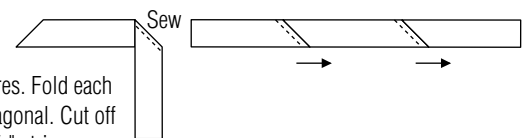


Appliqué:

Using templates provided, cut 12 hearts, 43 leaves, and 22 buds. Be sure to add 1/4" seam allowance.



Cut 1/2 yard of leaf print fabric into two 18" squares. Fold each of the squares on the diagonal. Cut off the fold, and cut into 1 1/4" strips as illustrated.



Sew strips together to make (8) 22" long strips. Strips are sewn right sides together. Press seams in one direction.

Fold strips in half lengthwise, right sides out. Stitch a scant 1/4" from the raw edge. Trim seam allowance. Insert a 3/8" bias bar into the bias tube and roll seam to the center of the bias bar. Press as you slide the bias bar through the inside of the 22" tube. The seam should be in the center back of the tube.



Using your favorite appliqué method, appliqué stems, buds, and leaves to the 7" borders. Refer to the cover photo of the quilt for placement.

Binding:

Sew 2 1/4" strips of binding fabric end to end, to form one continuous strip. This is a double binding. Press in half lengthwise. Bind as usual.
