

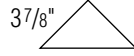
FOR THE DINING ROOM

TABLE RUNNER (68" x 20")

Cut 2 each 9" squares from the woven fabric (4823).

Cut 7 each 37/8" squares from green (4825-1 for Clr. 1 and 4822-21 for Clr. 2) and cut in half to make 14 triangles (2" x 4" finished).

Cut 5 strips 2" x 45" from light fabric (4822). Cut into 10" lengths.



Cut 5 strips 2" x 45" from vine fabric (4821). Cut into 10" lengths.

Cut 2 pieces of foundation material 13" x 30".

Cut light weight batting 20" x 60".

The runner is sewn on a foundation piece. Mark the center and 2" segment using pattern paper with a 1 inch grid. Begin from the bottom on both sides. Lay the 9" square on the point and sew a dark strip on both sides. Lay a triangle with the wide part at the top of the square, and sew with a 1/4" seam. Turn the triangle up, making sure the point is on the center line. Press to avoid pleats. Add a light strip on each side and press. Add another triangle. Continue until there are 7 triangles. It is very important that the point is on the center line each time. Finish with 2 strips and trim, leaving a seam in the center, and 12 1/2" wide. Sew the two ends together in the center and press open.

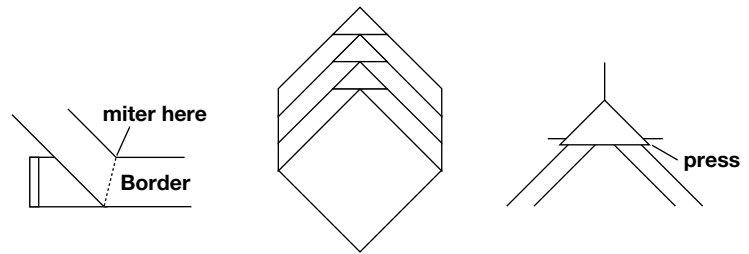
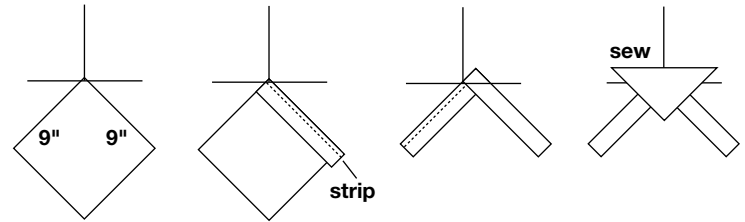
For Border – Cut 2 sides 3 1/2" x 43" from floral fabric (4814).

Cut 4 end strips 3 1/2" x 14" from floral fabric (4814).

Measure both sides of the runner and mark the border strip from the center, leaving the extra border for the mitered corners. Mitering the corners is the same as on a quilt only on a different angle. Sew the sides to the 1/4" seam allowance and backstitch. Sew the ends on in the same way. Fold over and press. Pin together, open and sew on the pressed seam. Trim exceed fabric. Press the seam towards the border.

Lay the finished top on the floral fabric and cut the back. Lay on a thin batting and pin together. Sew around the outside leaving a 6" opening on one side to turn.

Trim batting, turn and press well. Using the utility stitch, sew a top stitch on the inside edge of the border. This will give it stability and a finished look.
