

## Fabric Cutting Directions

From Fabric 1: Cut 76 strips 1 1/2" wide. From each of 64 strips,

Cut a piece 1 1/2" x 9 1/2". Cut a piece 1 1/2" x 8 1/2".

Cut a piece 1 1/2" x 7 1/2".

Cut a piece 1 1/2" x 6 1/2". Cut a piece 1 1/2" x 5 1/2".

Cut a piece 1 1/2" x 3 1/2".

From each of 8 strips, cut 8 pieces 1 1/2" x 4 1/2". From each of the 4 remaining strips, cut 16 pieces 1 1/2" x 2 1/2".

From Fabrics 2 & 6: For each fabric, cut 7 strips 1 1/2" wide.

From each of 3 strips, cut 11 pieces 1 1/2" x 3 1/2".

From each of 4 strips, cut 8 pieces 1 1/2" x 4 1/2".

From Fabrics 3 & 7: For each fabric, cut 11 strips 1 1/2" wide.

From each of 5 strips, cut 7 pieces 1 1/2" x 5 1/2"

From each of 6 strips, cut 6 pieces 1 1/2" x 6 1/2"

From Fabrics 4 & 8: For each fabric, cut 15 strips 1 1/2" wide.

From each of 7 strips, cut 5 pieces 1 1/2" x 7 1/2".

From each of 8 strips, cut 4 pieces 1 1/2" x 8 1/2".

From Fabrics 5 & 9: For each fabric, cut 20 strips 1 1/2" wide.

From each of 9 strips, cut 4 pieces 1 1/2" x 9 1/2".

From each of 11 strips, cut 3 pieces 1 1/2" x 10 1/2".

For Fabric 10: Refer to the First Border and Binding sections.

From Fabric 11: Cut 10 strips 7" wide for second border.

From Fabric 12: Cut 4 strips 2 1/2" wide. From each strip, cut 16 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2".

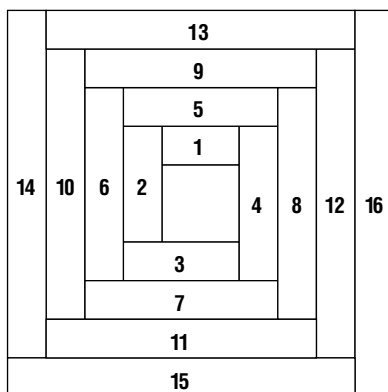
Fabric 13 is for Backing.

## To Make the Blocks

Right sides together, sew a 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Fabric 1 piece to a 2 1/2" Fabric 12 square. Repeat 63 times to make 64 block center units.

**Block A:** Make 32.

To add Log 2, sew a 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" Fabric 1 strip to the left side of the block center unit. Continue sewing the logs following the numbers in sequence as illustrated below. Logs 1, 2, 5, 6, 9, 10, 13 and 14 are made from Fabric 1. Logs 3 and 4 are made from Fabric 6. Logs 7 and 8 are made from Fabric 7. Logs 11 and 12 are made from Fabric 8. Logs 15 and 16 are made from Fabric 9.



**Block B:** Make 32.

Repeat the sewing procedure for making Block A. Logs 3 and 4 are made from Fabric 2. Logs 7 and 8 are made from Fabric 3. Logs 11 and 12 are made from Fabric 4. Logs 15 and 16 are made from Fabric 5.

## First Border

Cut all strips lengthwise one at a time making sure that each cut strip is exactly like the illustration below. For the first border, fussy cut 4 strips 2 1/4" wide x length of fabric. Using the fussy cut strips, cut two Fabric 10 strips 2 1/4" x 80 1/2" and two Fabric 10 strips 2 1/4" x 84" (if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top). Sew a 2 1/4" x 80" strip to the bottom and another to the top of the quilt. Sew a 2 1/4" x 84" strip to the left side and another to the right side of the quilt top.



## Second Border

Sew ten Fabric 11 strips together end to end to make a long 7" wide strip. From this long strip, cut two strips 7" x 84" and two strips 7" x 97" (if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top). Sew a 7" x 84" strip to the bottom and another to the top of the quilt. Sew a 7" x 97" strip to the left side and another to the right side to complete the quilt top.

## Binding

For the binding, cut 4 strips 2 1/4" wide x length of fabric. Fussy cutting the binding strips to match the first border is optional.

## To Assemble the Quilt Top

Using the diagram provided below, sew the blocks into rows, then sew the rows together.
