













MARDI GRAS

 Finished Quilt Size: 66³/₄" x 78³/₄"
 Finished Block Size: 12"

All seams are 1/4" – All strips are cut the width of the fabric, except as instructed otherwise – carefully trim all selvages.

1		5867-02	Cut 5 strips 4 ⁵ / ₈ " wide. Cut 80 Template A's. Make Template A from semi-transparent template plastic. 	1 yd
2		5866-04	Cut 7 strips 4" wide. Cut into 160 rectangles x 4". 	7/8 yd
3		5868-04	Cut 4 strips 3 ¹ / ₄ " wide. Cut into 80 rectangles 1 ¹ / ₂ " x 3 ¹ / ₄ ". Cut 4 strips 4" wide. Cut into 80 rectangles 1 ¹ / ₂ " x 4".	7/8 yd
*4		5866-41	Cut 8 strips 4 ¹ / ₂ " wide. Cut into 160 rectangles 1 ³ / ₄ " x 4 ¹ / ₂ ".	1 ¹ / ₈ yds
5		5867-04	Cut 7 strips 4 ¹ / ₂ " wide. Cut into 160 rectangles 1 ¹ / ₂ " x 4 ¹ / ₂ ".	1 yd
6		5869-04	Cut 7 strips 4 ¹ / ₂ " wide. Cut into 160 rectangles 1 ¹ / ₂ " x 4 ¹ / ₂ ".	1 yd
7		5866-01	Cut 7 strips 4" wide. Cut into 160 rectangles 1 ¹ / ₂ " x 4".	7/8 yd
*8		5869-01	Cut 4 strips, lengthwise , 2 ¹ / ₂ " by length of fabric for the 2nd border. From the remaining fabric, cut 8 strips 4" wide by width of fabric (fabric is approximately 32" wide). Cut into 160 rectangles 1 ¹ / ₂ " x 4".	2 ¹ / ₄ yds
9		5863-01	See Cutting Border Print directions.	6 ¹ / ₂ yds
10		5747-06	Binding	3/4 yd
11	Any Coordinating Fabric for Backing			4 ⁷ / ₈ yds

* Yardage and cutting for the Red colorway differs from the chart above in Fabrics 4 & 8 because of the 2nd border. (Refer to Fabric Requirement & Cutting chart for Red colorway on following page.) For block construction, Fabric numbers are the same for the two colorways.

Cutting Border Print

Make sure to leave a 1/4" seam allowance beyond the outside edge of each border strip.

1. Make Templates B and C from semi-transparent template plastic. Draw the 1/4" seam allowance line on the template and a line down the center of the template.
2. From the wide strip on the border print fabric, cut 2 strips 6¹/₈" x 84" for the top and bottom of the quilt, and 4 strips 6¹/₈" x 54" for the sides.
3. From the narrow strip on the border print fabric, cut 2 strips 2" x 60" for the top and bottom of the quilt, and 4 strips 2" x 40" for the sides. When cutting strips, cut on the exact center of the narrow connecting strip.

4. Using Templates B and C, cut 80 of Template B, and 80 of Template C from the remaining wide strips of the border print fabric.
