

2. To construct Units G and G(r), make 4 strip sets as shown in Figures #3 and #4. When sewing the strip sets together, offset the lighter fabric by 1 1/2". Follow Figure #3 for Unit G(r) and Figure #4 for Unit G to determine left or right offset. Make sure to press seams as the arrows below indicate.

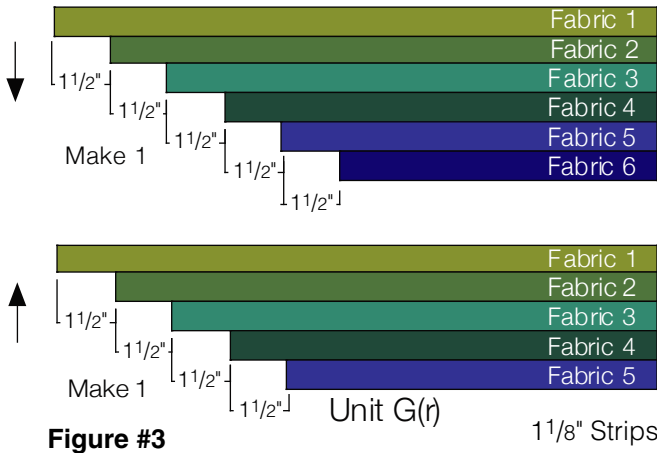

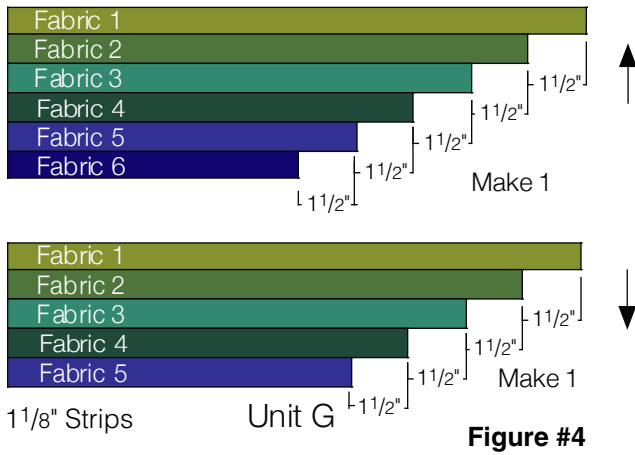

3. To make Units C, C(r), G and G(r), cut the end of each strip set at a 30° angle. Cut eight 2 1/4" strips from each C, C(r), G, and G(r) unit making sure the 30° angle remains constant. For Unit C and Unit G(r), cut the diagonal to the left as shown in Figure #5. For Unit C(r) and Unit G, cut the diagonal to the right as shown in Figure #6. Ensure the strip set is in the proper order before cutting - lighter fabric on top and darker fabric on the bottom of the strip set.

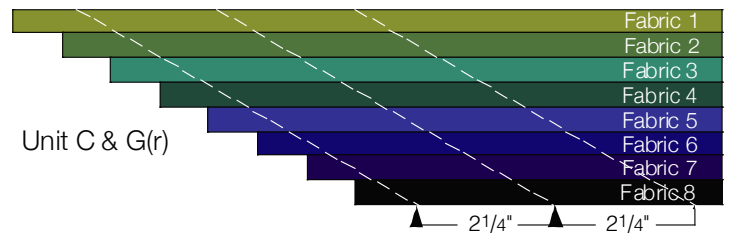

Cut eight 2 1/4" strips from each set.

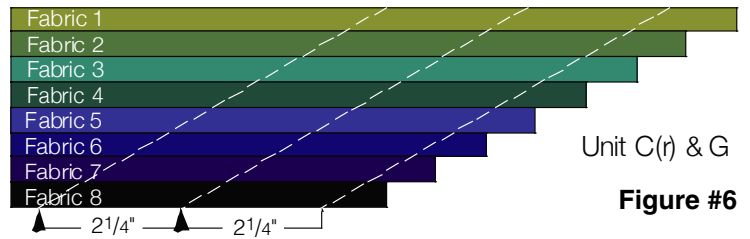

4. For Unit C, put together three 30° strips as shown in Figure #7. Make sure the seams are in the direction of the arrows. Make 8.

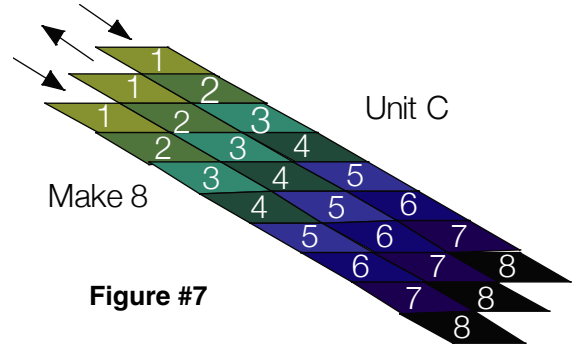

5. For Unit C(r), put together three 30° strips as shown in Figure #8. Make sure the seams are in the direction of the arrows. Make 8.

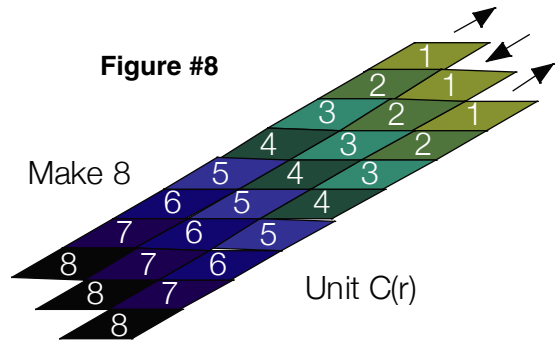

6. For Unit G(r), put together one of each of the 30° strip sets as shown in Figure #9. Make 8. Add the Template L piece cut from fabric # 4 to each strip set next to Fabric #5 as shown in Figure #9.

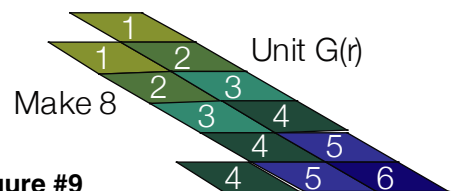
