

Piecing the Wedge Units

See Figure #3.

1. Sew Unit A to Unit B. Repeat for all eight wedges.
2. Sew Unit A(r) to Unit B(r). Repeat for all eight reverse wedges.
3. Sew Unit C to Unit D. Repeat for all eight wedges.
4. Sew Unit C(r) to Unit D(r). Repeat for all eight reverse wedges.
5. Sew Unit E to Unit F. Repeat for all eight wedges.
6. Sew Unit E(r) to Unit F(r). Repeat for all eight reverse wedges.
7. Sew Unit G to Unit H. Repeat for all eight wedges.
8. Sew Unit G(r) to Unit H(r). Repeat for all eight reverse wedges.
9. Sew Unit I to Unit J. Repeat for all eight wedges.
10. Sew Unit I(r) to Unit J(r). Repeat for all eight wedges.

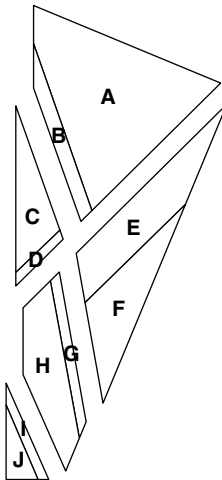

11. Sew Unit AB to Unit CD. Repeat for all eight wedges.
12. Sew Unit AB(r) to Unit CD(r). Repeat for all eight wedges.
13. Sew Unit EF to Unit GH. Repeat for all eight wedges.
14. Sew Unit EF(r) to Unit GH(r). Repeat for all eight wedges.

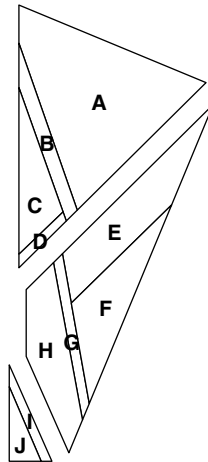

15. Sew Unit EFGH to Unit IJ. Repeat for all eight wedges.
16. Sew Unit EFGH(r) to Unit IJ(r). Repeat for all eight wedges.
17. Sew Unit ABCD to Unit EFGHIJ. Repeat for all eight wedges.
18. Sew Unit ABCD(r) to Unit EFGHIJ(r). Repeat for all eight wedges.

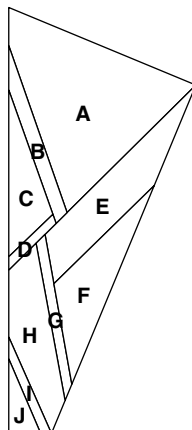

19. Piece the completed wedge unit to its reverse unit along the straight seam. When complete, the right side will be the exact mirror image of the left side.

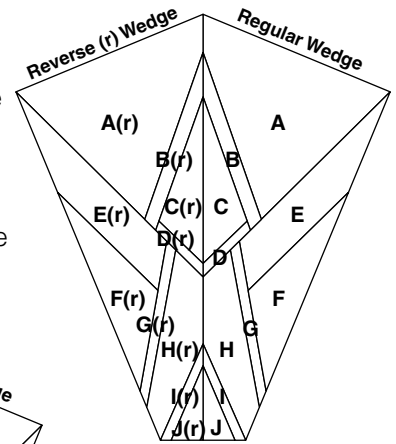

20. Piece K to the units created in Figure #6. Complete for all 8 sets.

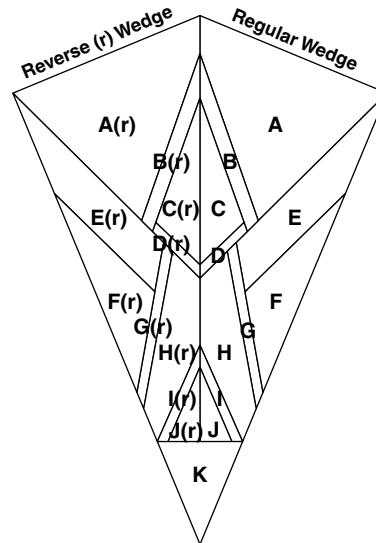

Making the Kaleidoscope Design

1. Piece together 4 completed wedges and then piece together the remaining four wedges as shown in Figure #8. Join the two sections together to create an octagon. The completed octagon is shown in Figure #9.

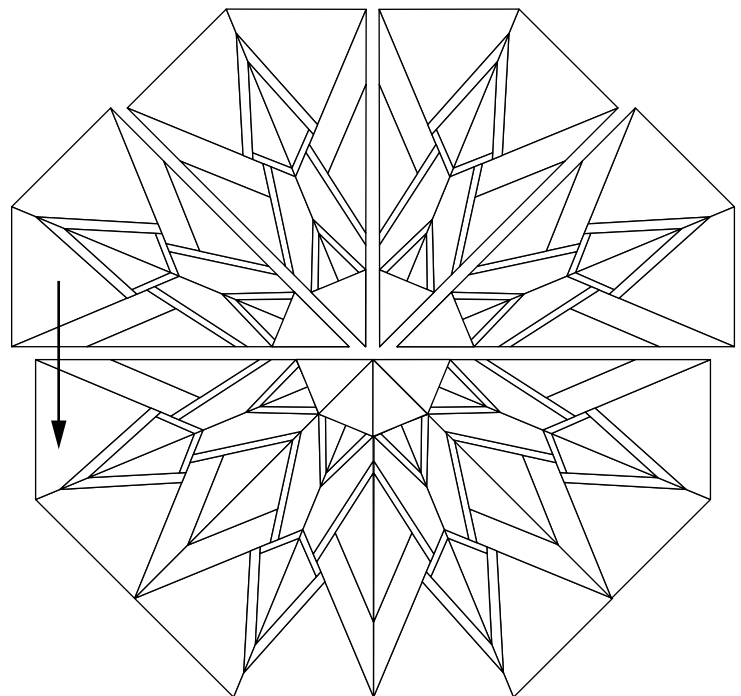
