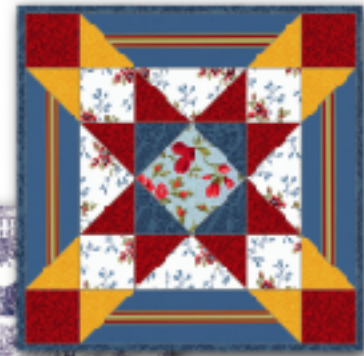




Euro Sham

Euro Shams

Fabric Requirements (2 Euro Shams)

Fabric Swatch	Style #	Description	Yardage
	4944-2	large floral print	3 ¹ / ₄ yards
	4953-2	check print	1 yard
muslin for lining			1 ¹ / ₂ yards

Cutting Instructions

From large floral print, cut:

- (2) – 24¹/₂" squares
- (4) – 18¹/₂" x 30¹/₂" rectangles

From check print, cut:

- (4) – 3¹/₂" x 24¹/₂" border strips
- (4) – 3¹/₂" x 30¹/₂" border strips

From muslin, cut:

- (2) – 24¹/₂" squares for lining

Assemble the Sham Tops

1. To make one sham top, place a large floral 24¹/₂" square on top of one muslin 24¹/₂" square with their wrong sides together. Pin in place. Baste together using an 1/8" seam allowance.
2. Sew one check print 3¹/₂" x 24¹/₂" strip to the sham top. Repeat with the sham bottom. Press the seam allowance toward the border strips. In the same manner, sew the check print 3¹/₂" x 30¹/₂" strips to the sham side edges. Press the seam allowance toward the border strips. The sham top measures 30¹/₂" square, including the seam allowances.
3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 to make a total of two sham tops.

Assemble the Sham



1. To create the hem of the sham back, fold to the wrong side 1/2" on a long edge of a large floral print 18¹/₂" x 30¹/₂" rectangle; press. Then fold the pressed edge under an additional 1", press. Topstitch the hem. Repeat on a second large floral 18¹/₂" x 30¹/₂" rectangle.
2. Lay both backing rectangles with their right sides facing down. Overlap the hemmed edges of the two backing rectangles so that the total size of the backing is 30¹/₂" square, including the seam allowances. Baste the top and bottom edges where the hems overlap. Repeat steps 1 and 2 to make a total of two sham backs.
3. With right side together and aligning all edges around, sew together the pillow sham top and the pillow sham back. Clip the corners and turn the pillow sham right side out; press.
4. Finish the pillow sham with a flange by stitching in the ditch, through all layers, between the large floral print and the check print. Insert a 24" pillow through the opening in the back. Repeat steps 3 and 4 to make a second pillow sham.

Pillow Case

Fabric Requirements (2 Pillow Cases)

Fabric Swatch	Style #	Description	Yardage
	4950-2	blue toile print	2 yards
	4953-2	blue check print	1/8 yard

Cutting Instructions

From blue toile print, cut:

- (2) – 26¹/₂" x 40¹/₂" rectangles
- (2) – 6³/₄" x 40¹/₂" border strips

From blue check print, cut:

- (2) – 1" x 40¹/₂" piping strips

Assemble the Pillow Case

1. With wrong sides together and along the long length, press the blue check print 1" x 40¹/₂" in half. Place the blue check print strip atop the long edge of the blue toile print 26¹/₂" x 40¹/₂" rectangle. Machine baste together a scant 1/4" seam. Pillow case still measures 26¹/₂" x 40¹/₂", including the seam allowances.
2. Place the blue toile print 6³/₄" x 40¹/₂" border strip atop both layers of the basted edge of the pillow case. Match edges and pin in place. Sew together and make sure the blue toile print of the pillow case and the border are in the same direction. Press the seam allowance toward the border. The pillow case measures 32¹/₂" x 40¹/₂", including the seam allowances.
3. Fold the pillow case in half the long length of the pillow case. Sew along the short side and the long side of the pillow case, matching edges, seam lines and leaving the border edge open.
4. To create the hem, fold to the wrong side of the pillow case 1/2" along the border edge and press. Fold under an additional 3" that will lay over the seam allowance, between the pillow case and the border; press, pin in place and machine baste. Turn the pillow case right side out. Sew a topstitch close to the blue check print piping going through the top layer and the bottom layer of the blue toile print border. Pillow case measures 20" x 29" finished. Repeat to make a second pillow case.
