






# Remember When

Finished size 73<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 53<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"

All strips are to be cut crosswise on the grain of the fabric (width of the fabric) unless otherwise noted. Yardage is calculated for 42" wide fabric. Carefully trim off all selvages. All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise indicated. **Please read the pattern carefully before you begin.**

## Fabric Cutting Directions and Requirements

Fabric Swatch	Fabric #	Style #	Cutting Directions	Yardage
	1	5132-2	Cut 1 strip 71 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " wide. From this strip, cut 2 squares 71 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 71 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> ". To save fabric, trim the unused portion of this strip to 4" wide. From this trimmed strip, cut 6 squares 4" x 4". Cut 3 strips 4" wide. From the first strip, cut 8 squares 4" x 4". From each of the remaining 2 strips, cut 4 rectangles 4" x 71 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> ". Cut 5 strips 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " wide. From each of 3 strips, cut 8 rectangles 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " x 4". From each of the remaining 2 strips, cut 12 squares 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " x 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> ". Cut 6 strips 5 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " wide. Set these strips aside for the outer border.	2 yds
	2	5135-2	Cut 1 strip 51 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " wide. From this strip, cut 4 squares 51 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 51 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> ". Set these squares aside for the outer border. Cut 2 strips 4" wide. From each strip, cut 8 squares 4" x 4". Cut 1 strip 27 <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " wide. From this strip, cut 8 squares 27 <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " x 27 <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub> ". Cut 3 strips 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " wide. From each strip, cut 16 squares 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " x 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> ". Cut 1 strip 15 <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " wide. From this strip, cut 24 squares 15 <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " x 15 <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub> ". Cut 6 strips 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " wide. Set these aside for the inner border.	13 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> yds
	3	5134-1	Cut 1 strip 77 <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " wide. From this strip, cut 5 squares 77 <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " x 77 <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub> ". Cut each square once from corner to corner on the diagonal to make 2 triangles. Cut 1 strip 103 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " wide. From this strip, cut 2 squares 103 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " x 103 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> ". Cut each square once from corner to corner on the diagonal to make 2 triangles. To save fabric, trim the unused portion of this strip to 77 <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " wide. From this trimmed strip, cut 1 square 77 <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " x 77 <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub> ". Cut this square once from corner to corner on the diagonal to make 2 triangles.	3 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub> yd
	4	5135-3	Cut 7 strips 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " wide for the quilt binding.	1 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> yd
	5	5129-1	Cut 6 squares 14 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 14 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " being careful to center the hankie motif in each square.	1 yd

### To Make the Large Snowball Stars:

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the 27<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 27<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" red (Fabric #2) squares. Right sides together, layer a marked red square with a 71<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 71<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" snowflake print (Fabric #1) square and sew on the drawn line as shown in Illustration 5. Trim unit 1/4" from the seam line. Fold the red triangle up and press to make the unit shown in Illustration 6. Repeat this procedure for all four corners of the snowflake print square to make the unit shown in Illustration 7. Repeat the entire procedure for the other 71<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" snowflake print square. The construction of this block's star points is identical to the procedure used to make the green stars in the Noel Wall Hanging. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the 4" squares of red fabric. Right sides together, layer a marked red square with a 4" x 71<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangle of snowflake print, as shown in Illustration 1. Sew on the marked line. Trim unit 1/4" from the seam line. Fold the red triangle up and press to make the unit pictured in Illustration 2. Repeat this procedure for the other end of the rectangle to make the unit shown in illustration 3. Repeat the entire procedure to make 8 large star point units. Assemble the large snowflake star blocks

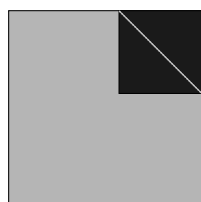

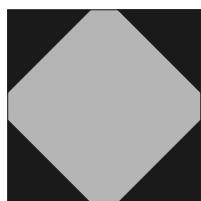

as shown in Illustration 8. Sew a large star point unit to the left side and one to the right side of each snowball square. Press the seams toward the squares. Sew a 4" snowflake print square to each end of the remaining star point units. Press the seams toward the snowflake print squares. Sew one of these units to the top and one to the bottom of each snowball square unit. Press the seams toward the snowball squares.

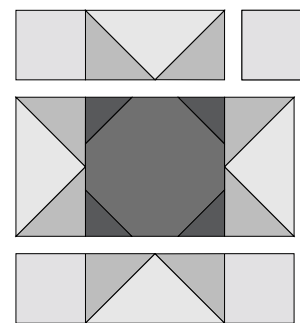

### To Make the Small Snowball Stars:

The procedure for making the small snowball stars is identical to that used for making the large snowball stars. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the 15<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 15<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" red (Fabric #2) squares. Right sides together, layer a marked red square with a 4" x 4" snowflake print (Fabric #1) square, and sew on the drawn line as shown in Illustration 5. Trim unit 1/4" from the seam line. Fold the red triangle up and press to make the unit shown in Illustration 6. Repeat this procedure for all four corners of the snowflake print square to make the unit shown in Illustration 7. Repeat the entire procedure for the 5 remaining 4" x 4" snowflake print squares. The construction of this block's star points is identical to the procedure used to make the green stars in the Noel Wall Hanging. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the
