

wrong side of the $2\frac{1}{4}$ " squares of red fabric. Right sides together, layer a marked red square with a $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x 4" rectangle of snowflake print fabric as shown in Illustration 1. Sew on the marked line. Trim unit $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the seam line. Fold the red triangle up and press to make the unit pictured in Illustration 2. Repeat this procedure for the other end of the rectangle to make the unit shown in Illustration 3. Repeat the entire procedure to make 24 small star point units. Assemble the small snowflake star blocks as shown in Illustration 8. Sew a small star point unit to the left side and one to the right side of each small snowball square. Press the seams toward the squares. Sew a $2\frac{1}{4}$ " snowflake print square to each end of the remaining star point units. Press the seams toward the squares. Sew one of these units to the top and one to the bottom of each small snowball square unit. Press the seams toward the snowball squares.

To Assemble the Quilt:

Sew a $7\frac{7}{8}$ " triangle of white fabric to the top and another to the right-hand side of a small snowball star block to make 1 small star unit as shown in Illustration 9. The quilt top is assembled in diagonal rows as shown in Illustration 10. After all of the rows are sewn together, sew a $10\frac{7}{8}$ " triangle of white fabric to each of the quilt's four corners.

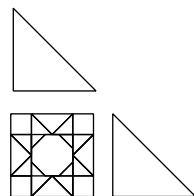

To Add the Borders:

Trim 2 of the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " red fabric strips to $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40" (if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt). Sew one of these strips to the left side and one to the right side of the quilt top. Press the seams toward the red fabric.

Sew the remaining $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips of red fabric together end to end to make a long $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip. From this strip, cut 2 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $63\frac{3}{4}$ " (if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt). Sew a strip to the top and a strip to the bottom of the quilt. Press the seams toward the red fabric. Trim 2 of the $5\frac{1}{2}$ " snowflake print strips to $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 44" (if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt). Sew one strip to the left side and one to the right side of the quilt top. Press the seams toward the red inner border. Sew the remaining $5\frac{1}{2}$ " snowflake print strips together end to end to make a long $5\frac{1}{2}$ " strip. From this long strip, cut 2 shorter strips $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $63\frac{3}{4}$ " (if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt). Sew a $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square of red fabric to each end of the two $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $63\frac{3}{4}$ " strips of snowflake print fabric. Press the seams toward the red squares. Sew one border unit to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt. Press the seams toward the red inner border.

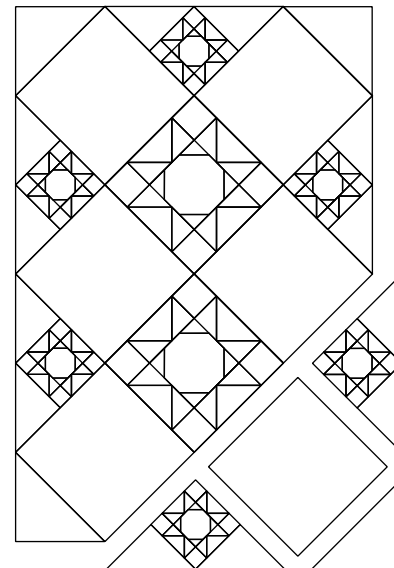

Remember When Table Runner

Finished size $59\frac{1}{4}$ " x $19\frac{3}{4}$ "

All strips are to be cut crosswise on the grain of the fabric (width of the fabric) unless otherwise noted. Yardage is calculated for 42" wide fabric. Carefully trim off all selvages. All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " unless otherwise indicated. **Please read the pattern carefully before you begin.**

Fabric Cutting Directions and Requirements

Fabric Swatch	Fabric #	Style #	Cutting Directions	Yardage
	1	5132-2	Cut 1 strip 4" wide. From this strip, cut 4 squares 4" x 4". Cut 3 strips $2\frac{1}{4}$ " wide. From 1 strip, cut 16 squares $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x $2\frac{1}{4}$ ". From each of the remaining 2 strips, cut 8 rectangles $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x 4".	$\frac{1}{2}$ yd
	2	5135-2	Cut 6 strips $2\frac{1}{4}$ " wide. Set 4 of these strips aside for the binding. From each of the remaining 2 strips, cut 16 squares, $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x $2\frac{1}{4}$ ". Cut 1 strip $1\frac{5}{8}$ " wide. From this strip, cut 16 squares $1\frac{5}{8}$ " x $1\frac{5}{8}$ ".	$\frac{1}{2}$ yd
	3	5134-1	Cut 1 strip $7\frac{7}{8}$ ". From this strip, cut 4 squares $7\frac{7}{8}$ " x $7\frac{7}{8}$ ". Cut each square once from corner to corner on the diagonal to make 2 triangles.	$\frac{1}{2}$ yd
	4	5129-1	Cut 3 squares $14\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " being careful to center the hankie motif in each square.	$\frac{1}{2}$ yd

To Make the Table Runner:

Make 4 small snowball stars following the directions given in the section: To Make the Small Snowball Stars. Make 4 small snowball star units as explained above and shown in Illustration 9. Assemble the table runner in diagonal rows as shown in Illustration 11.

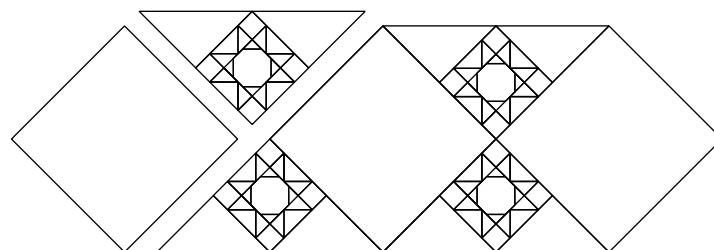
