Finished Quilt Size: 88" x 88" Square

All strips are to be cut on crosswise grain of the fabric (width of the fabric). All strips are based on 42" long strips. Carefully trim off all selvages. **PLEASE READ THE PATTERN CAREFULLY BEFORE YOU BEGIN.**

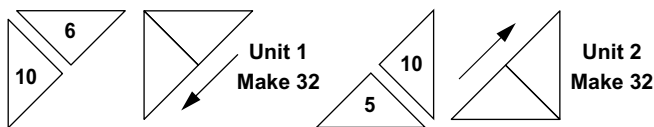
Block 1 - Empire Star (11" Finished) Make 8 Blocks

Fabric Cutting Directions

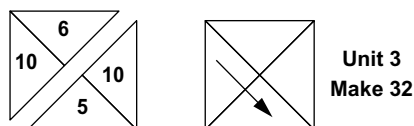
Fabric #	Description	Cutting
1	Nile Pansy	Cut 1 - 2 ³ / ₈ " wide strip, Cut strip into 16 - 2 ³ / ₈ " squares
3	Copen Tapestry	Cut 2 - 2 ³ / ₈ " wide strips, Cut strips into 32 - 2 ³ / ₈ " squares
5	Black Eyelash	Cut 1 - 3 ⁷ / ₈ " wide strip, Cut strip into 8 - 3 ⁷ / ₈ " squares, Cut across both diagonals for a total of 32 triangles 
6	Midnight Marble	Cut 3 - 3 ⁷ / ₈ " wide strips, Cut strips into 20 - 3 ⁷ / ₈ " squares, Cut across both diagonals for a total of 80 triangles 
10	Ruby Feather	Cut 2 - 3 ⁷ / ₈ " wide strips, Cut into 16 - 3 ⁷ / ₈ " squares, Cut across both diagonals for a total of 64 triangles 
11	Cherry Fern	Cut 1 - 3 ¹ / ₈ " wide strip, Cut strip into 8 - 3 ¹ / ₈ " squares
15	Misty Blue Palm	Cut 2 - 6 ³ / ₈ " wide strips, Cut strips into 8 - 6 ³ / ₈ " squares, Cut once on diagonal for a total of 16 triangles 

Block 1 Construction

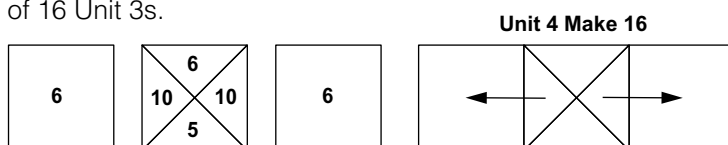
Sew a 3⁷/₈" triangle of Fabric 6 to a 3⁷/₈" triangle of Fabric 10 to make a Unit 1. Sew a 3⁷/₈" triangle of Fabric 10 to a 3⁷/₈" triangle of Fabric 5 to make a Unit 2. *Press toward the direction of the arrows.*



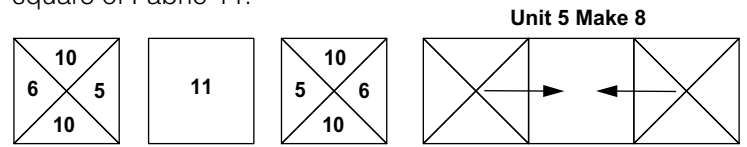
Sew a Unit 1 and a Unit 2 together to make a Unit 3 (Make sure the colors are in the correct position).



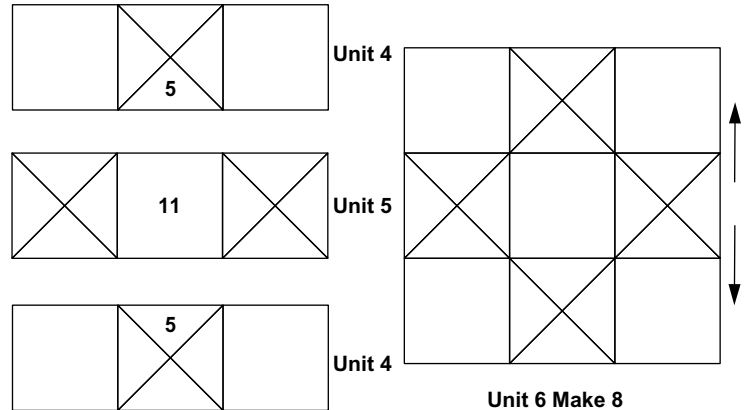
Sew a 3¹/₈" square of Fabric 6 to each Fabric 10 side of 16 Unit 3s.



Sew a Unit 3 Fabric 5 side to two opposite sides of a 3¹/₈" square of Fabric 11.

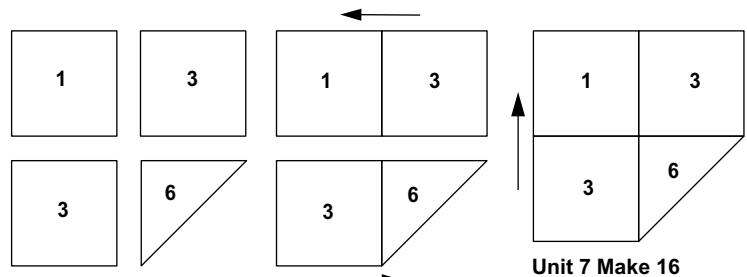


Sew a Unit 4 to the top and bottom of a Unit 5 (Make sure the colors are in the correct positions). See the piecing diagram below.



Block 1 Pieced Corner Units

Sew a 2³/₈" square of Fabric 1 to a 2³/₈" square of Fabric 3, and sew a 2³/₈" square of Fabric 3 to a 3⁷/₈" triangle of Fabric 6. Sew together as illustrated. *Press toward the direction of the arrows.*



Sew a 3⁷/₈" Fabric 6 triangle to each Fabric 3 square in Unit 7 as illustrated.
