







## Block 3 & 3R (Reverse) - Keystone

(11" Finished) **Make 8 & 8R**

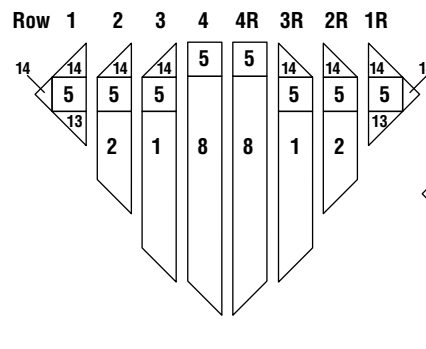
### Fabric Cutting Directions

Fabric #	Description	Cutting
13	Olive Crackle	Cut 1 - 21/4" wide strip, Cut into 8 - 21/4" squares  Cut once on the diagonal to make 16 triangles
2	Chartreuse Fossil	Cut 2 - 17/8" wide strips, fold strips in half  wrong sides together. Using Template A, cut 8 & 8R as illustrated. Each cut will make a Template A and A Reverse.
1	Yellow Green Alligator	Cut 4 - 17/8" wide strips, fold as illustrated for Fabric 2. Using Template B cut 8 & 8R.
8	Spring Green Crackle	Cut 4 - 17/8" wide strips, fold as illustrated for Fabric 2. Using Template C, cut 8 & 8R.
5	Purple Florentine	Cut 3 - 17/8" wide strips, Cut into 64 - 17/8" squares
6	Teal Tapestry	Cut 4 - 63/8" wide strips, Cut into 24 - 63/8" squares Cut once on the diagonal to make 48 triangles 
14	White Paisley	Cut 2 - 107/8" wide strips, Cut into 4 - 107/8" squares.  Cut twice on the diagonal to make 16 triangles. Cut 1 - 17/8" wide strip, Cut into 8 - 17/8" squares. Cut once on the diagonal to make 16 triangles. Cut 2 - 21/4" wide strips, Cut into 24 - 21/4" squares Cut once on the diagonal to make 48 triangles 
15	White Lilac Pinecone	Cut 2 - 63/8" wide strips, Cut into 8 - 63/8" squares. Cut once on the diagonal to make 16 triangles 

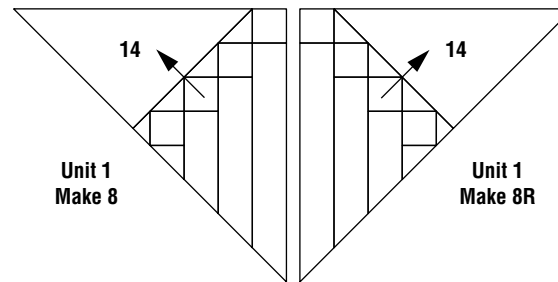
### Block 3 & 3R Construction

Sew a 17/8" Fabric 5 square to the end of 16 each of Fabrics 13, 2, 1, & 8. Layout as illustrated. Sew a 21/4" triangle of Fabric 14 to the end of strip sets 1 - 3 and 1R - 3R. Fabric 14 triangles are mirror images. Be sure to sew them on correctly. Sew a 17/8" triangle of Fabric 14 to the side of strip sets

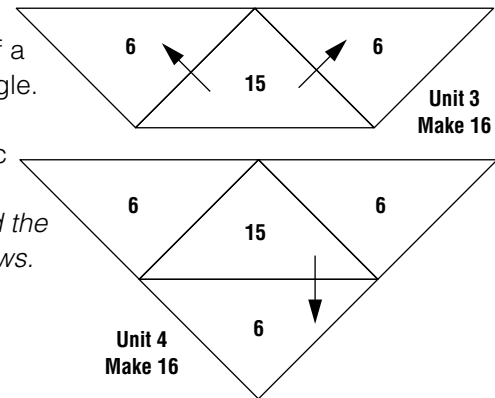

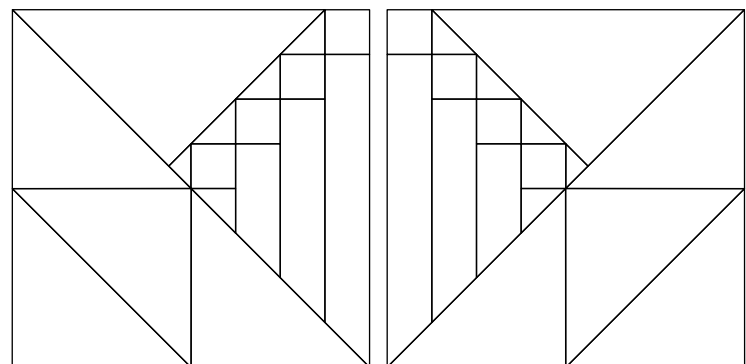
Sew strip sets 1 - 4 together, and strip sets 1R - 4R together. Make 8 each of strip sets 1 - 4 and 8 each of strip sets 1R - 4R to make 8 Unit 1's and 8 Unit 1R's. *Press seams open.* Sew a 107/8" triangle to each Unit 1 and 1R as illustrated. *Press seams toward the direction of the arrows.*



Sew a 63/8" Fabric 6 triangle to 2 sides of a 63/8" Fabric 15 triangle. Sew a 63/8" Fabric 6 triangle to the Fabric 15 side of Unit 3. *Press seams toward the direction of the arrows.*



Sew a Unit 4 to a Unit 2, and a Unit 2R to make a complete block. *Press seams open.*
