


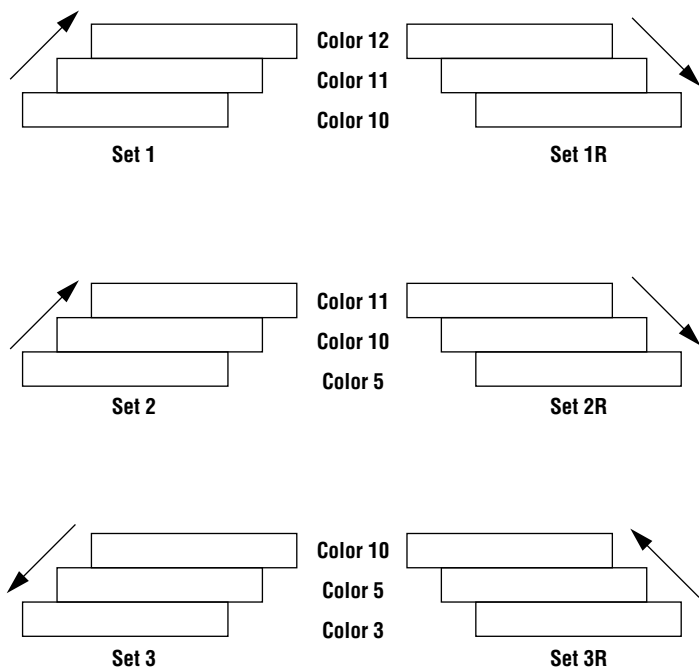
## Block 4 - Sunburst (22" Finished)

### Fabric Cutting Directions

Fabric #	Description	Cutting
6	Teal Tapestry	Cut 1 - 12 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " wide strip, Cut into 1 - 12 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " square Cut across both diagonals to make 4 triangles Cut the remainder of the strip down to 6", Cut 4 - 6" squares
5	Purple Florentine	Cut 2 - 2 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " wide strips Cut each strip in half to make 4 half-strips as illustrated. 
11	Azure Astor	Cut 2 - 2 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " wide strips, Cut into 4 half-strips as illustrated for Fabric 5
10	Turquoise Paisley	Cut 3 - 2 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " wide strips, cut into 6 half-strips as illustrated for Fabric 5
3	Viridian Crackle	Cut 1 - 2 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " wide strips, cut into 2 half-strips as illustrated for Fabric 5
12	Jade Florentine	Cut 1 - 2 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub> " wide strip Cut into 2 - half inch strips as Illustrated for Fabric 5

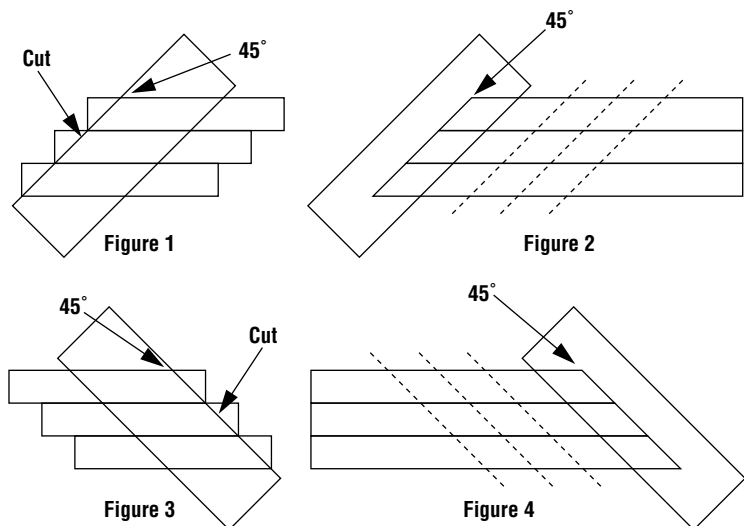
### Block 4 Construction

Using the 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 21" half-strips make 6 strip sets one each of 1, 1R, 2, 2R, 3, & 3R. Sew strips together off-setting the strips by approximately 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" as illustrated below. *Press seams toward the direction of the arrows.*

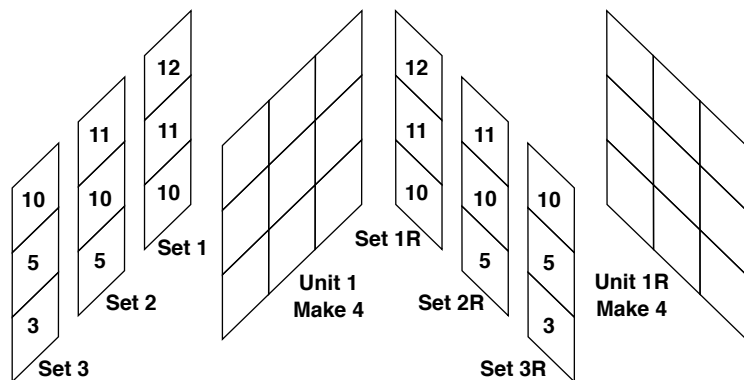


### Cutting 45° Angle Diamonds

Line up the 45° angle on the ruler with the tip edge of set 1. Trim the edge as shown in **Figure 1**. After trimming the edge cut 4 - 1<sup>13</sup>/<sub>16</sub>" segments as shown in **Figure 2**. Use a ruler grided in 1/16" or use the cutting guide on page 5. Repeat for set 2 and 3. Trim the edge of set 1R as shown in **Figure 3**. Continue cutting as shown in **Figure 4**. Cut 4 - 1<sup>13</sup>/<sub>16</sub>" segments. Repeat for set 2R and 3R.



Sew one each of sets 1, 2, and 3 together to make star points. Make 4. *Press seams open.* Sew one each of sets 1R, 2R, and 3R together to make reverse star points. Make 4. *Press seams open (See Hint for Sewing Set Together).*



### Hint for Sewing Set Together

Seams are not going in the same direction, they cross at the 1/4" seam allowance. Pin each intersection. The pin should be placed where corresponding seams meet. Sew carefully.
