Finished quilt size 58 5/8" x 79 3/8"

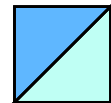
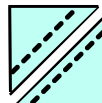
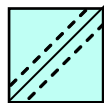
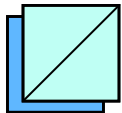
All strips are to be cut crosswise on the grain of the fabric (width of the fabric) unless otherwise noted.

Yardage is calculated for 42" wide fabric .

Carefully trim off all selvages. Please read the pattern carefully before you begin .

Fabric #	Cutting Instructions
1	Cut 8 strips 7" wide for the outer border.
2	Cut 8 strips 4 7/8" wide. Cut 8 squares 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" from each strip. Cut each square once on the diagonal to make two triangles.
3	Using the quilts pictured as a guide, cut 4 lengthwise strips 3 3/4" wide x length of fabric with a set of small stripes carefully centered in each strip.
4	Cut 11 strips 1 7/8" wide. Cut 20 squares 1 7/8" x 1 7/8" from each strip. Cut 7 strips 2 3/4" wide for the inner border. Cut 8 strips 2 1/4" wide for the binding.
5	Cut 22 strips 1 7/8" wide. Cut 20 squares 1 7/8" x 1 7/8" from each strip.
6	Cut 11 strips 1 7/8" wide. Cut 20 squares 1 7/8" x 1 7/8" from each strip.
7	Cut 11 strips 2" wide. Cut 20 squares 2" x 2" from each strip.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 1 7/8" Fabric 5 squares. Right sides together, layer a Fabric 5 square with a Fabric 4 square. Sew 1/2" on either side of the drawn line. Cut the unit apart on the marked line and press the seams toward the darker fabric. Make 440.



Repeat this procedure for the 1 7/8" Fabric 6 and Fabric 5 squares. Make 440.

Following the block assembly diagram, sew four pieced squares together to make one pinwheel block. Make 110 pinwheel blocks from the Fabric 5 and 4 pieced squares and 110 pinwheel blocks from the Fabric 5 and 6 pieced squares. Sew four pinwheel blocks together to complete one large block. Make 55.
