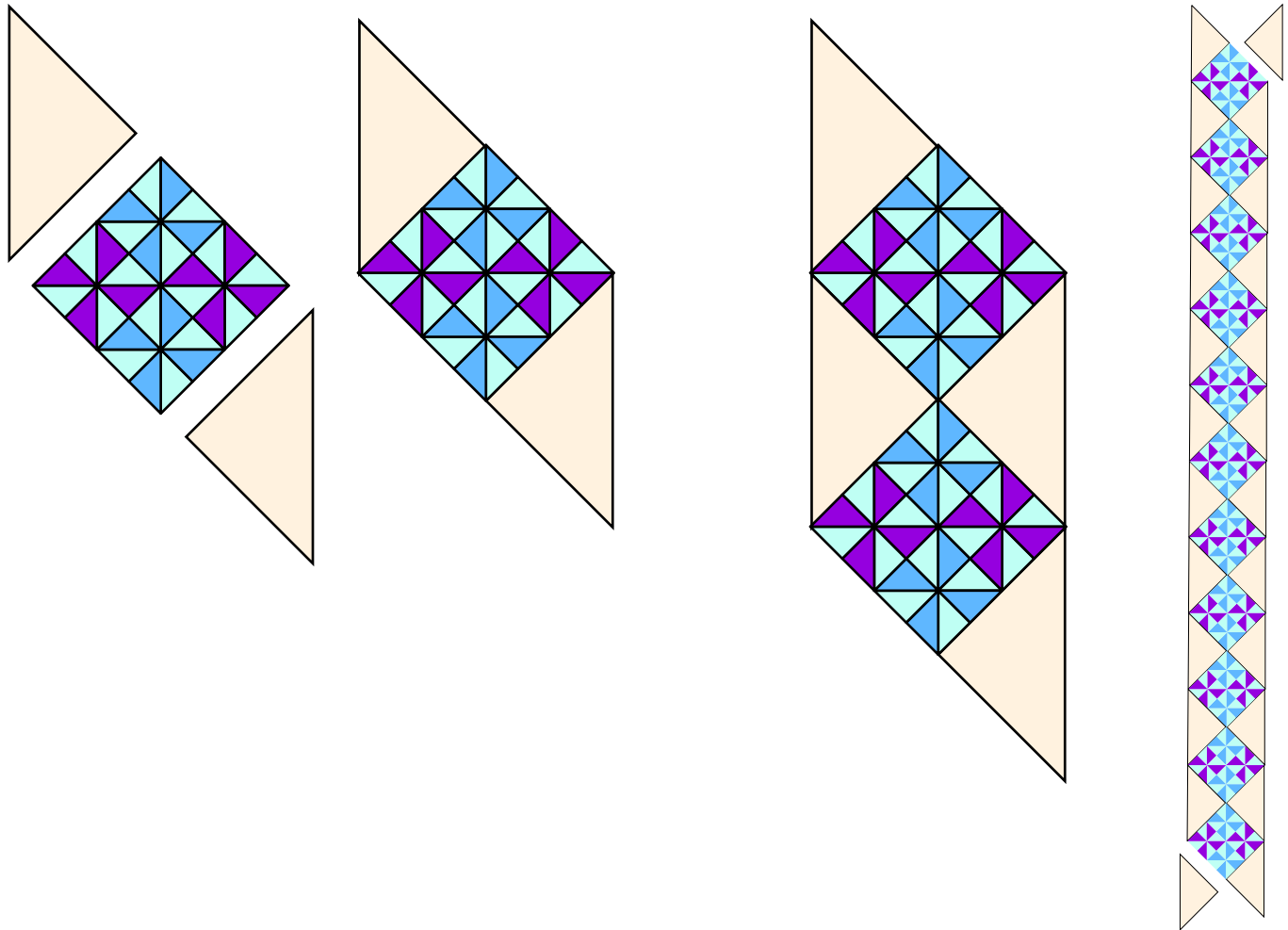


Following the strip assembly diagram below, sew the large blocks and the Fabric 2 triangles together as shown. Add the extra Fabric 2 triangles as shown. Make 5 pieced strips, with 11 large pinwheel blocks each.



Trim the ends of the strips. Leave $1/4$ " seam allowance from the corner of the large pinwheel blocks.

Trim the Fabric 3 strips to $62\ 3/4$ " (if your measurements are different, cut to fit your pieced strips).

Using the quilts pictured as a guide, sew the pieced strips and Fabric 3 strips together.

Trim the selvages from the 7 strips of Fabric 4. Sew the strips end to end to make a long strip. Cut 2 strips $62\ 3/4$ " long (if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top). Sew these strips to the left and right sides of your quilt top. Cut 2 strips $46\ 1/8$ " (if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top). Sew these strips to the top and bottom of your quilt top.

Trim the selvages from the 8 strips of Fabric 1. Sew the strips end to end to make a long strip. Cut 2 strips 65 " long (if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top). Sew these strips to the left and right sides of your quilt top. Cut 2 strips $52\ 5/8$ " (if your measurements are different, cut to fit your quilt top). Sew these strips to the top and bottom of your quilt top.

Layer the completed quilt top with batting and backing fabric and quilt as desired. Trim the completed quilt and bind as desired.
