

Tomorrow's Shining Star by Robert Callaham

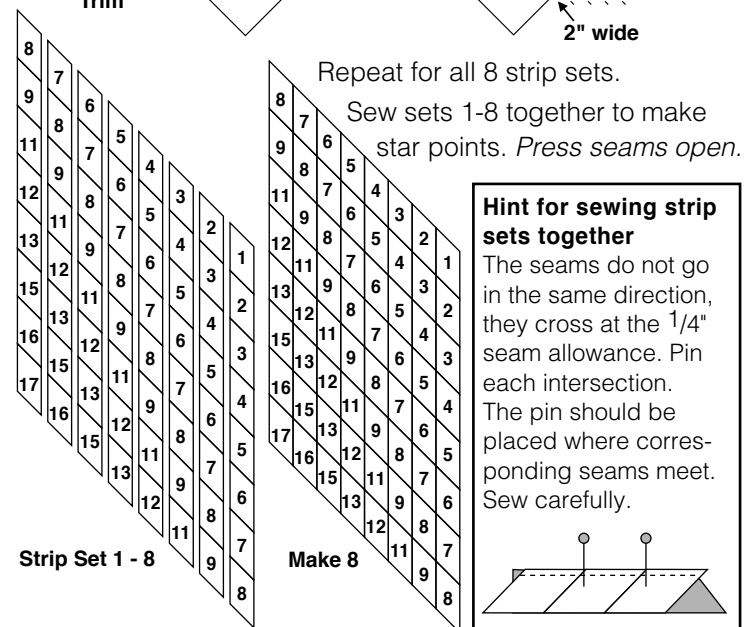
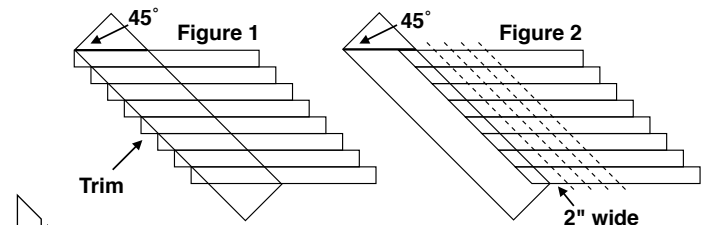
Finished Quilt Size: 74" x 74"

All strips are to be cut on crosswise grain of the fabric (width of the fabric). All strips are based on 42" long strips. Carefully trim off all selvages. **PLEASE READ THE PATTERN CAREFULLY BEFORE YOU BEGIN.**

Cutting Directions for the Center Star

Fabric #	Description	Strip Cutting
1	Mint Etch	1 Strip
2	Celedon Paisley	2 Strips
3	Apple Green Aster	3 Strips
4	Forest Paisley	4 Strips
5	Spruce Aster	5 Strips
6	Mediterranean Boxwood	6 Strips
7	Wedgewood Paisley	7 Strips
8	Royal Feather	8 Strips
9	Sapphire Rose	7 Strips
11	Turkey Red Pinecone	6 Strips
12	Ruby Feather	5 Strips
13	Carmin Rose	4 Strips
15	Magenta Aster	3 Strips
16	Mulberry Boxwood	2 Strips
17	Mayflower Coral Bells	1 Strip

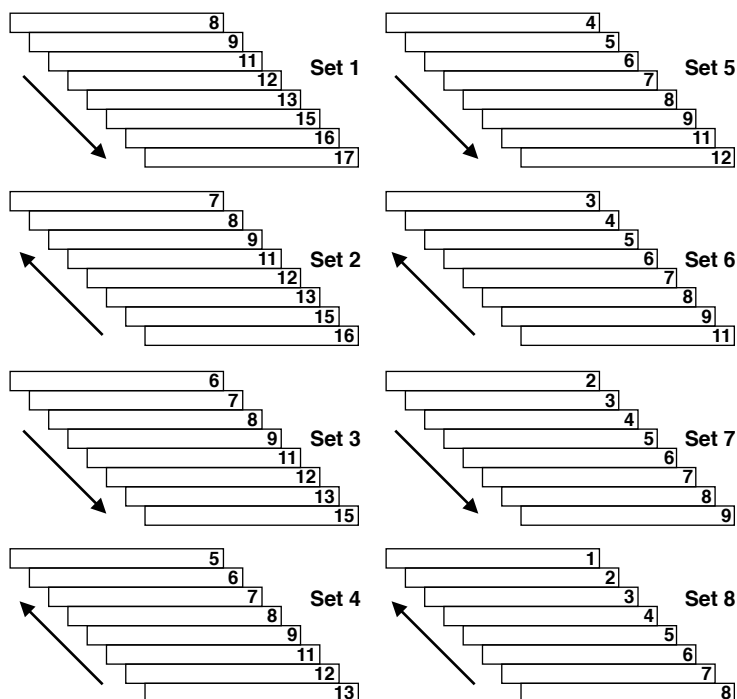
To cut 45° angle diamonds, line up the 45° angle on the ruler with the top edge of a strip set, trimming the edge as shown in **Figure 1**. After trimming the edge, cut each strip set into



Hint for sewing strip sets together
The seams do not go in the same direction, they cross at the 1/4" seam allowance. Pin each intersection. The pin should be placed where corresponding seams meet. Sew carefully.

Block Construction

Using the 2" wide strips make 8 strip sets. Sew the strips together, off-setting the strips approximately 2" as illustrated below. Press toward the direction of the arrows. Make one of each strip set.

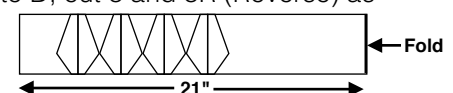


Cutting Instructions for Appliqué Units

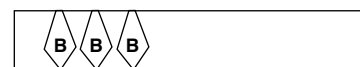
Fabric Cutting Directions

6	Mediterranean Boxwood	Cut 1 - 3 1/2" wide strip and 2 - 3 3/4" wide strips
7	Wedgewood Paisley	Cut 2 - 3 1/4" wide strips
10	Eggplant Primrose	Cut 2 - 1 3/4" wide strips
14	Ocher Aster	Cut 1 - 4" wide strip

Fold the 3 1/2" wide strip of Fabric 6, in half *wrong sides* together. Using Template D, cut 8 and 8R (Reverse) as illustrated. Each cut will make 1 D and 1 DR.



From the 3 1/2" wide strips of Fabric 6, cut 32 of Template B.



From the 3 1/2" wide strips of Fabric 7, cut 40 of Template A.



From the 1 3/4" wide strips of Fabric 10, cut 40 of Template C.



From the 4" wide strip of Fabric 14, cut 8 of Template E.
