



To Make the Paper Foundations:

The center square, obelisk blocks and palm frond blocks are all made by paper piecing. Make four Foundation 1 units by enlarging the pattern provided 200% and printing two per page on 8 1/2" x 11" paper. Make sixteen each of Foundations 2 and 3 by enlarging the pattern provided 200% and printing one per page on 8 1/2" x 14" paper. Make four each of Foundations 4 and 5 by enlarging the pattern provided 200% and printing one per page on 11" x 17" paper. To prepare the foundations for use, trim all the foundations on the outermost lines. Trim four each of Foundations 2 and 3 - 1/4" beyond the bottom of the triangle marked "5". These foundations will be used for the smaller palm frond blocks in the quilt's large center square.
