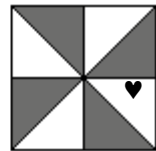
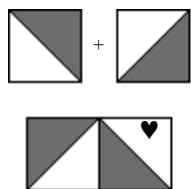


Fabric Key	Swatch	Style No.	Cutting Directions	Yardage
9		6546-03	Cut 2 strips 37/8" wide, and cut into 16 squares 37/8" x 37/8". Cut each square once on the diagonal.	3/8 yd
10		6549-02	Cut 2 strips 37/8" wide, and cut into 12 squares 37/8" x 37/8". Cut each square once on the diagonal.	3/8 yd
11		6551-02	Cut 2 strips 37/8" wide, and cut into 12 squares 37/8" x 37/8". Cut each square once on the diagonal.	3/8 yd
4		6547-03	Binding	1 1/4 yds
12		6553-02	Suggested Backing	9 yds

Pinwheel Block Construction

- To make pinwheel block place a 37/8" triangle of fabric 1 right sides together with a 37/8" triangle of fabric 4 and sew as illustrated. Open the square. Press the seam open. Make 30 of unit 1.
- Place a 37/8" triangle of fabric 3 right sides together with a 37/8" triangle of fabric 4. Sew and press as illustrated in step 1.
- Using 3 of unit 1 and 1 of unit 2, sew a pinwheel block together as illustrated.

Following steps 1-3 make the following pinwheel blocks.

Block B	Using fabrics 1 and 5 make 35 of unit 1. Using fabrics 3 and 5 make 1 of unit 2. Sew 8 of block B together using 4 of unit 1 and 1 block B using 3 of unit 1 and 1 of unit 2 for a total of 9 of block B.
Block C	Using fabrics 1 and 6 make 31 of unit 1. Using fabrics 3 and 6 make 1 of unit 2. Sew 7 of block C together using 4 of unit 1 and 1 block C using 3 of unit 1 and 1 of unit 2 for a total of 8 of block C.
Block D	Using fabrics 1 and 7 make 20 of unit 1. Sew 5 of block D together using 4 of unit 1. This block does not contain a unit 2.
Block E	Using fabrics 1 and 8 make 42 of unit 1. Using fabrics 3 and 8 make 14 of unit 2. Sew 14 of block E together using 3 of unit 1 and 1 of unit 2.
Block F	Using fabrics 1 and 9 make 32 of unit 1. Sew 8 of block F together using 4 of unit 1. This block does not contain a unit 2.
Block G	Using fabrics 1 and 10 make 24 of unit 1. Sew 6 of block G together using 4 of unit 1. This block does not contain a unit 2.
Block H	Using fabrics 1 and 11 make 20 of unit 1. Using fabrics 3 and 11 make 4 of unit 2. Sew 2 of block H together using 4 of unit 1 and 4 block H using 3 of unit 1 and 1 of unit 2 for a total of 6 of block H.
