Read all instructions before starting.

Fabrics & Seams

It is recommended that fabrics are 100 % cotton. All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ ".

We recommend pressing the seams flat towards one side (not open) unless otherwise stated.

Black	Block sashings	Cut 8 strips ($1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42")	1 st - 4 th strips: Cut each strip into 3($1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11") strips. 5 th - 8 th strips: Cut each strip into 3($1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ ") strips.
Handspray	Borders	Cut 6 strips ($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42")	1 st and 2 nd strip: Cut each into 1($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ ") strip. 3 rd strip: Cut into 1($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ "), 1($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12"), 1($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "), 2($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ") strips. 4 th strip: Cut into 1($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ ") and 1($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $18\frac{1}{2}$ ") strip. 5 th strip: Cut into 1($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ ") and 1($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ ") strip. 6 th strip: Cut into 1($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ "), 1($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ "), 1($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "), 1($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ ") and 1($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2") strips

Adding the sashings:

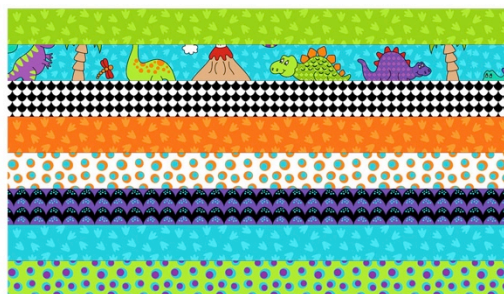
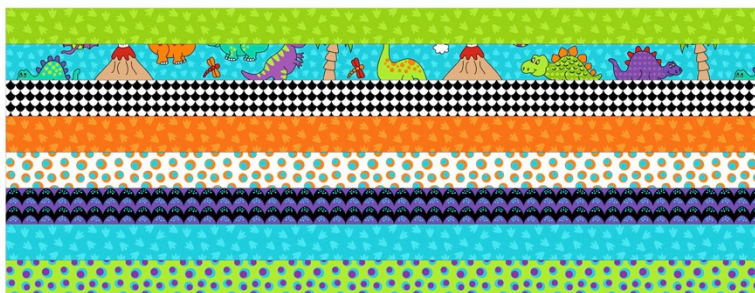
Trim the 6 large blocks from the panel so that they measure (11" x 11") square. (You will still have some of the black footprint around the outside of the block.)

Add a (1½"x11") black sashing to the top and bottom of each block, and a (1½"x12½") black sashing to each side of each block.



Top Section:

Join 8 (2½" x 42") strips together as shown below. Cut an 8½" and a 6½" piece from the joined strips. Put the remainder aside for the bottom section.



(Choose 18 ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") you wish to use for the vertical strips and cut each in half so it measures approximately 20" in length. Use one half for this top section and out the other half of each strip aside for the bottom section)

Section 1: Use the ($8\frac{1}{2}$ "x $16\frac{1}{2}$ ") piece from above.

Section 2: Join a ($7\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ ") handspray strip to the top of the ($5\frac{1}{2}$ "x $5\frac{1}{2}$ ") footprint block and a ($4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ ") strip to the bottom.

Section 3: Join 2 of the ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") strips and trim to ($16\frac{1}{2}$ ")

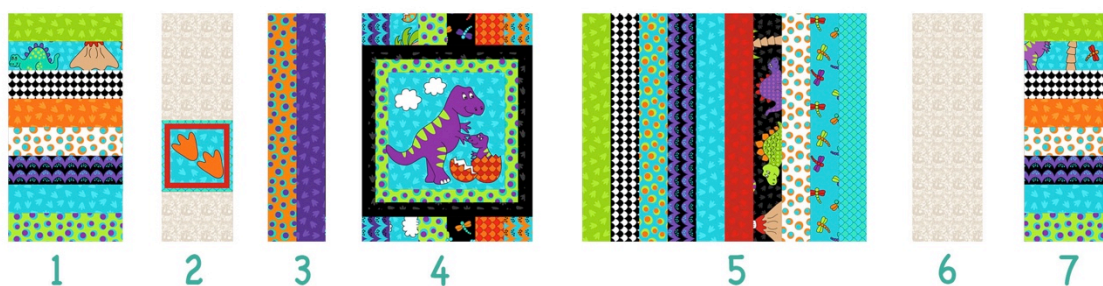
Section 4: Join 6 of the ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") strips and cut into two pieces, the first one measuring (3 " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ ") and the other measuring (2 " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ "). Join the first piece to the top of the T-rex block and the second piece to the bottom.

Section 5: Join the remaining 10 ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") strips and trim to ($16\frac{1}{2}$ ").

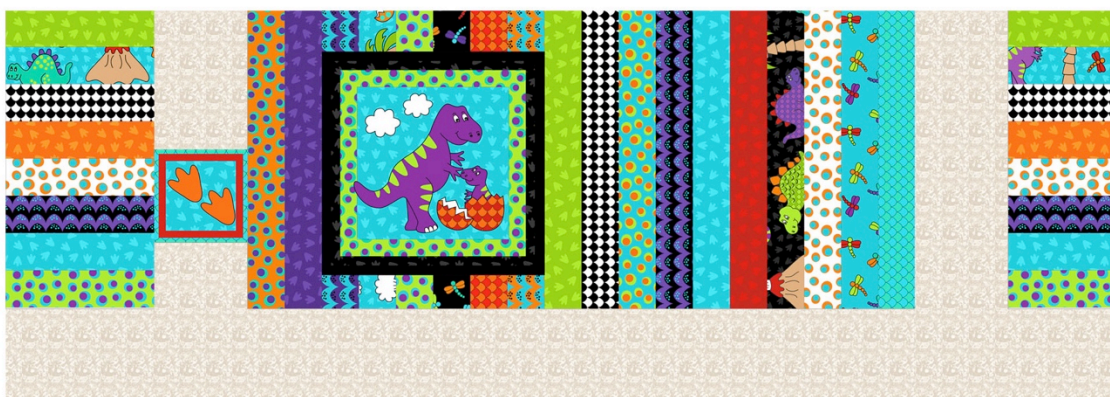
Section 6: ($5\frac{1}{2}$ "x $16\frac{1}{2}$ ") handspray.

Section 7: Use the ($6\frac{1}{2}$ "x $16\frac{1}{2}$ ") piece from above.

Join all sections together in the order shown below.



Join a ($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ ") and a ($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ ") to make a ($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ ") handspray strip and attach to the bottom of the top section.

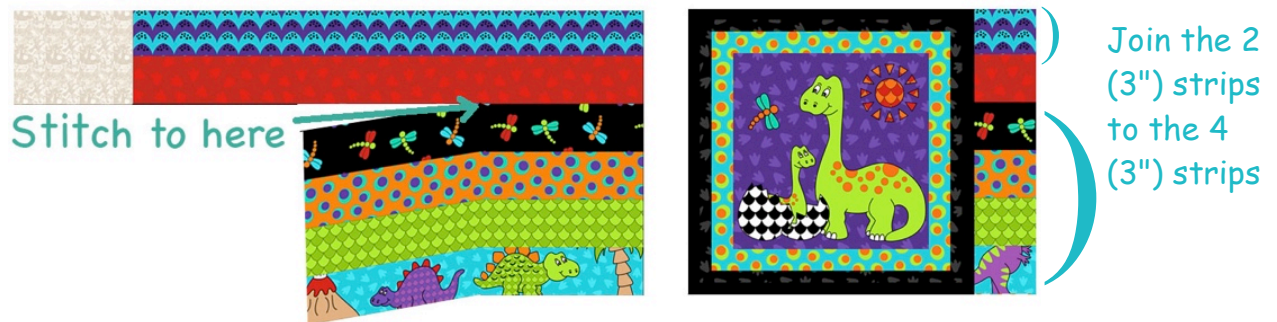


Middle Section:

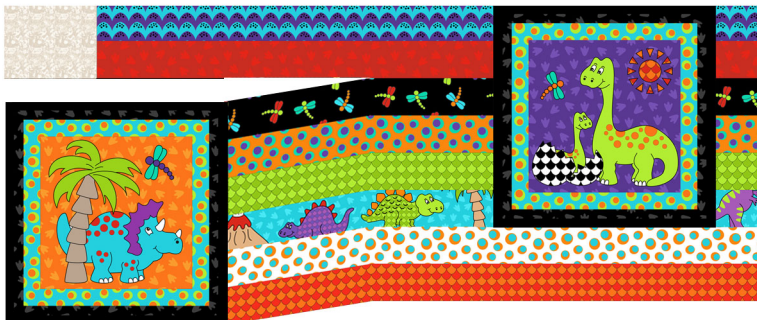
1. Join 2 ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") strips together and cut into a 3" strip and a 22" strip. Attach a handspray ($5\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ ") piece to the left of the 22" strip. Join 4 more ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") strips together and cut into a 3" strip and a 15" strip. Join the 2 (3") strips to the top of the 4 (3") strips as shown in the diagram below and attach to the right of the dino block.

Align the right edges of the 2 joined strips cut to 22", with the right edges of the 4 joined strips cut to 15". Stitch these together approximately 6" (it is important not to stitch the entire seam at this stage)

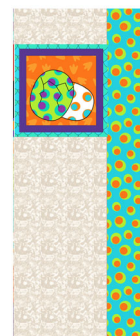
Join the 6 strips to the left of the dino block as shown below.



2. Join 2 ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") strips together and cut down to $29\frac{1}{2}$ ". Attach to the bottom of the above section. Attach a dinosaur block to the left as shown below. Now finish the seam above the dinosaur block.



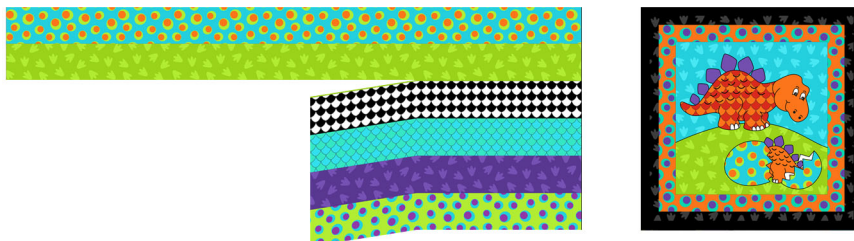
3. Attach a ($5\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ ") handspray strip to the top of one of the small panel squares. Then attach a ($5\frac{1}{2} \times 11\frac{1}{2}$ ") to the bottom. Trim one of the ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") strips to $18\frac{1}{2}$ " and attach to the right. (Put the remainder of this strip aside for step 8.



4. Trim a ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") strip to $36\frac{1}{2}$ " and attach to the bottom of this section starting at the right and stitching it only $\frac{1}{2}$ way along. Attach the handspray strip with the small egg block to the right.



5. Join 2 ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") strips together and trim to $31\frac{1}{2}$ ". Join 4($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") strips together and trim to a $15\frac{1}{2}$ " section and a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " section (put aside the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " section aside for a later step). Attach the $15\frac{1}{2}$ " section to the bottom of the two strips trimmed to $31\frac{1}{2}$ " starting stitching at the right side and stitching only half way along. Attach a Dino block to the right of these strips.



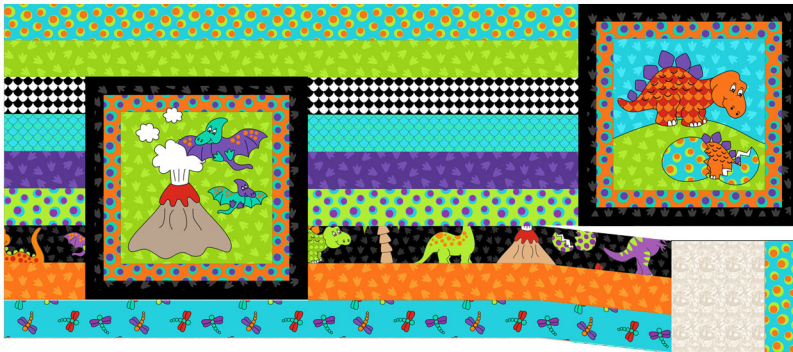
6. Join 2 ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") strips together and trim to a $20\frac{1}{2}$ " section and a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " section (put the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " section aside for the next step). Attach the $20\frac{1}{2}$ " section to the bottom as shown below, begin stitching at the left side and stitch the seam half way only.



7. Attach a Dino block to the left of the strips. Join the 2 ($4\frac{1}{2}$ ") sections together, (ensuring the strips are in the same order as those to the right of the dino block). Attach these strips to the left of the Dino block as shown below. Finish the seam above the Dino block.



8. Attach a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ $36\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the bottom on this section, then attach a $5\frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ $6\frac{1}{2}$ " handspray block to the right. Using the remainder of the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip from step 3 trim it to $6\frac{1}{2}$ " and attach it to the right of the handspray. Finish the seam below the Dino block.



9. Attach section 2 to the bottom of section 1, then attach a ($5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $20\frac{1}{2}$ ") handspray strip to the left of section 2. Complete the seam across the centre of these sections as shown below.



10. Join 4 ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") strips together and trim to $36\frac{1}{2}$ ". Attach these to the left of the middle section. Join 2 ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") strips together and trim to $36\frac{1}{2}$ ". Attach these to the right of the middle section.



Bottom Section:

(For the vertical strips, use the remainder from the top section, ensuring that they are stitched together in the same order as the top section)

Section 1: Use the remaining ($16\frac{1}{2}$ " piece from the top section (8 ($2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips). Add another $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the top and trim into a $8\frac{1}{2}$ " section and a $6\frac{1}{2}$ " section. Use the $8\frac{1}{2}$ " piece for section 1 and the $6\frac{1}{2}$ " piece for section 6.

Section 2: Join a ($2" \times 5\frac{1}{2}"$) handspray strip to the top of the ($5\frac{1}{2}" \times 5\frac{1}{2}"$) egg block and a ($12" \times 5\frac{1}{2}"$) strip to the bottom.

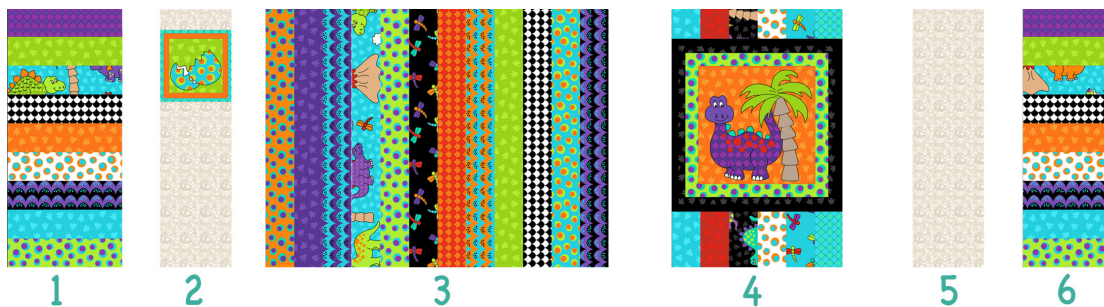
Section 3: Join 12 of the ($2\frac{1}{2}"$) strips and trim to ($18\frac{1}{2}"$)

Section 4: Join 6 of the ($2\frac{1}{2}"$) strips and cut into two pieces, the first one measuring ($3" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$) and the other measuring ($4" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$). Join the first piece to the top of the Dino block and the second piece to the bottom.

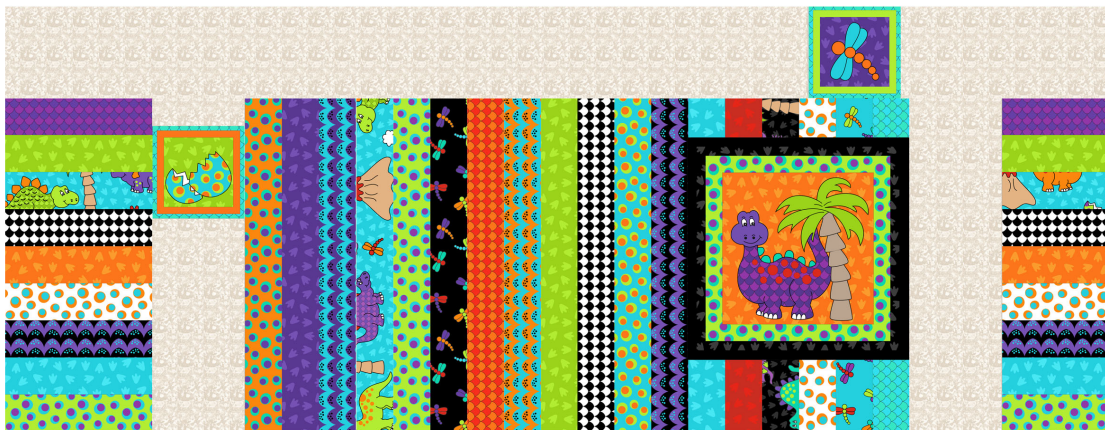
Section 5: ($5\frac{1}{2}" \times 18\frac{1}{2}"$) handspray.

Section 6: Use the ($6\frac{1}{2}" \times 18\frac{1}{2}"$) piece from above.

Join all sections together in the order shown below.

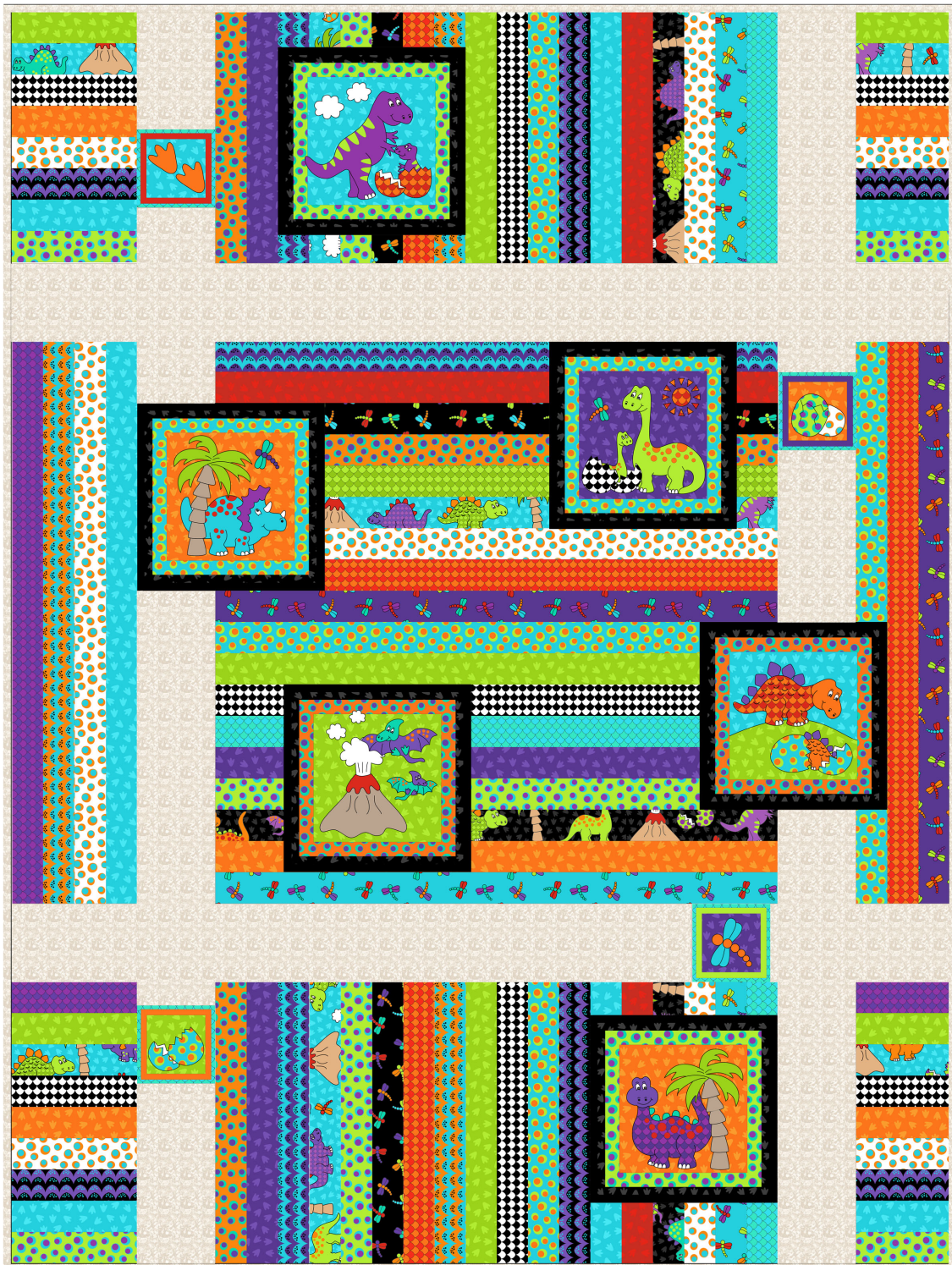


Join the ($5\frac{1}{2}" \times 40\frac{1}{2}"$) and ($5\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$) to make a ($5\frac{1}{2}" \times 43\frac{1}{2}"$) handspray strip and attach to the left of the ($5\frac{1}{2}" \times 5\frac{1}{2}"$) dragonfly block. Join a ($5\frac{1}{2}" \times 12\frac{1}{2}"$) handspray to the right of the dragonfly block then attach this strip to the top of the bottom section.



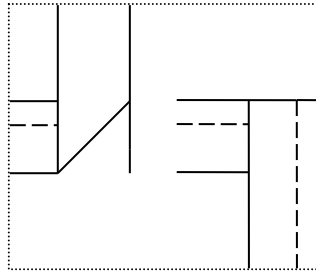
Assemble the quilt:

Join the top, middle and bottom sections together.



Binding & Quilt Assembly:

1. Cut batting and backing fabric 6" larger than quilt top.
2. On quilt top check all seams pressed and loose threads trimmed.
3. Pin or tape the backing layer right side down on a flat surface, then add the batting layer on top. Lay quilt top on batting layer right side up and smooth out any wrinkles. Baste or pin the three layers together in a 6" grid working out from the centre.
4. Machine or hand quilt as desired.
5. Trim batting and backing even with the quilt top.
6. **Binding:** Cut 7 ($2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42") handspray strips.
7. Binding: Join the ($2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42") strips and press the seams open. Fold the binding in half lengthwise wrong sides together and press it gently.
8. Leaving a four inch tail of fabric, begin stitching the binding halfway along one side of the quilt top.



9. Align the raw edges of the binding and the quilt top, stitch binding with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Stitch to $\frac{1}{4}$ " from corner of quilt and backstitch. Fold binding up to create a 45° angle then fold it down at 90°. Stitch from top edge to $\frac{1}{4}$ " from next corner and repeat process till 8" from the start. Join the ends to fit and finish attaching binding. Fold the binding to the back of the quilt and hand stitch it down.
10. Don't forget to personalise your quilt with a label on the back.
